Staff from the Planning & Building Services and Leisure & Community Services Departments, in consultation with the Mayor's Office, are hosting an Introductory Community Information Meeting to kick off the design of the new Skate Park. The Skate Park is proposed to be constructed in Memorial Park in 2013 to the south of the Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library / Leisure Centre adjacent Park Drive. The Skate Park project represents the first phase of development arising from Town Council's adoption in principal of the update to the Memorial Park Master Plan.



The purpose of this introductory Meeting is to review the project outline and timetable, and, to initiate the process of seeking comments from interested members of the Community on the design elements which could be incorporated into the future Skate Park. The information exchanged at this meeting will assist in creating initial design concepts / principles for the Skate Park.
