In this way the works speak to a specific moment in time before a decision comes to fruition, between a question and an answer and in doing so enables the cultural practices, rituals and value systems of the human experience to be explored."

Ms Heichert has exhibited her work in Ontario, Quebec and in Japan's Kyoto Municipal Museum.

The opening reception of The Matrix of Choice takes place Saturday from 1 to 3 p.m. Ms Heichert will be in attendance. Everyone is welcome.
