SITE ALTERATION BY-LAW

At the January 22, 2013 Council Meeting, Council will consider the passage of a new Site Alteration By-law. The purpose of the Site Alteration By-law is to regulate the manner in which site alterations, including the placement of fill, on lands in the Town will be permitted to take place. The By-law provides a mechanism for submitting applications, informing the public of pending applications, the issuance of permits and the preparation of agreements to regulate site alterations. NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT

The Town has initiated a Schedule "B" Class Environmental Assessment to review and evaluate the extension of sanitary sewer Sub-Trunk #1 to service lands east of the Tenth Line and north of Main Street in the Community of Stouffville. NO OVERNIGHT PARKING

December 1 to March 31 inclusive

GIFT OF LIFE ORGAN DONATION

Every three days someone dies in Ontario because the life-saving organ transplant they need is not available, yet less than 25% of Ontarians have registered their consent to be a donor. There are 1,500 people in our province waiting for organ transplants and the thousands more waiting for tissue transplants.

The Council of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville is committed to doing their part. They are asking every member of the municipality to register their consent for organ and tissue donation - it can be done online in just two minutes at www.beadonor.ca/town-of-whitchurch-stouffville. WINTER REMINDERS



- During the day, to assist with plowing operations, do not park vehicles on the street until they have been serviced
- Stay well back of snow plows when driving. On occasion, the plows are required to back-up
- Do not allow children to play on snow piles located near the roads. Snow plow operators may not see them
- The municipality is not responsible for damage to items placed on Town Property by property owners. Examples of such items are fences, posts, hedges, shrubs, concrete and wood driveway curbs. Removal of these items will aid in our road and sidewalk plowing operations and prevent damage
- Place garbage containers, green bins and blue boxes in driveways rather than on snow banks

RECYCLING/WASTE COLLECTION CONTAINER SIZE REMINDERS



Residents are reminded that blue box recycling materials will be collected only in a molded rigid open top container not exceeding 65cm (26 inches) in length, 50cm (20 inches) in width and 50cm (20 inches) in height. Blue boxes or containers covered with lids or nets will not be collected.

Cardboard must be broken down to 90cm x 90cm x 30cm (36"x36"x12") dimensions, newspaper and boxboard bundled and tied can be placed next to the blue box for collection to provide more volume in your blue box.

Containers not accepted for collection include:

- containers including contents weighing over 22 kg (50 pounds)
- oversized (approx 128 litre) containers with wheels and lid which are sold at some local improvement stores. The overall weight, size and durability of these containers prevent safe and effective collection
- plastic bags, loose grocery/kitchen catcher bags
- cardboard boxes
- do not cover recycling with a net or lid

TIPS FOR RESIDENTS ON WINDY RECYCLING/WASTE COLLECTION DAYS

- Arrange your blue box content so that the heavier items sit on top of the lighter items. You can also stack the blue boxes if there is more than one with heavier items placed in the blue box that is on the top
- Tightly secure the latch on the green bin
- Skip that week's collection and put their recycling out for next week's collection. There is no limit on the amount of blue box material put out for weekly collection
- You can also take their recycling to York Region's recycling depot at 225 Garfield Wright Blvd., East Gwillimbury, Thursday to Monday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
