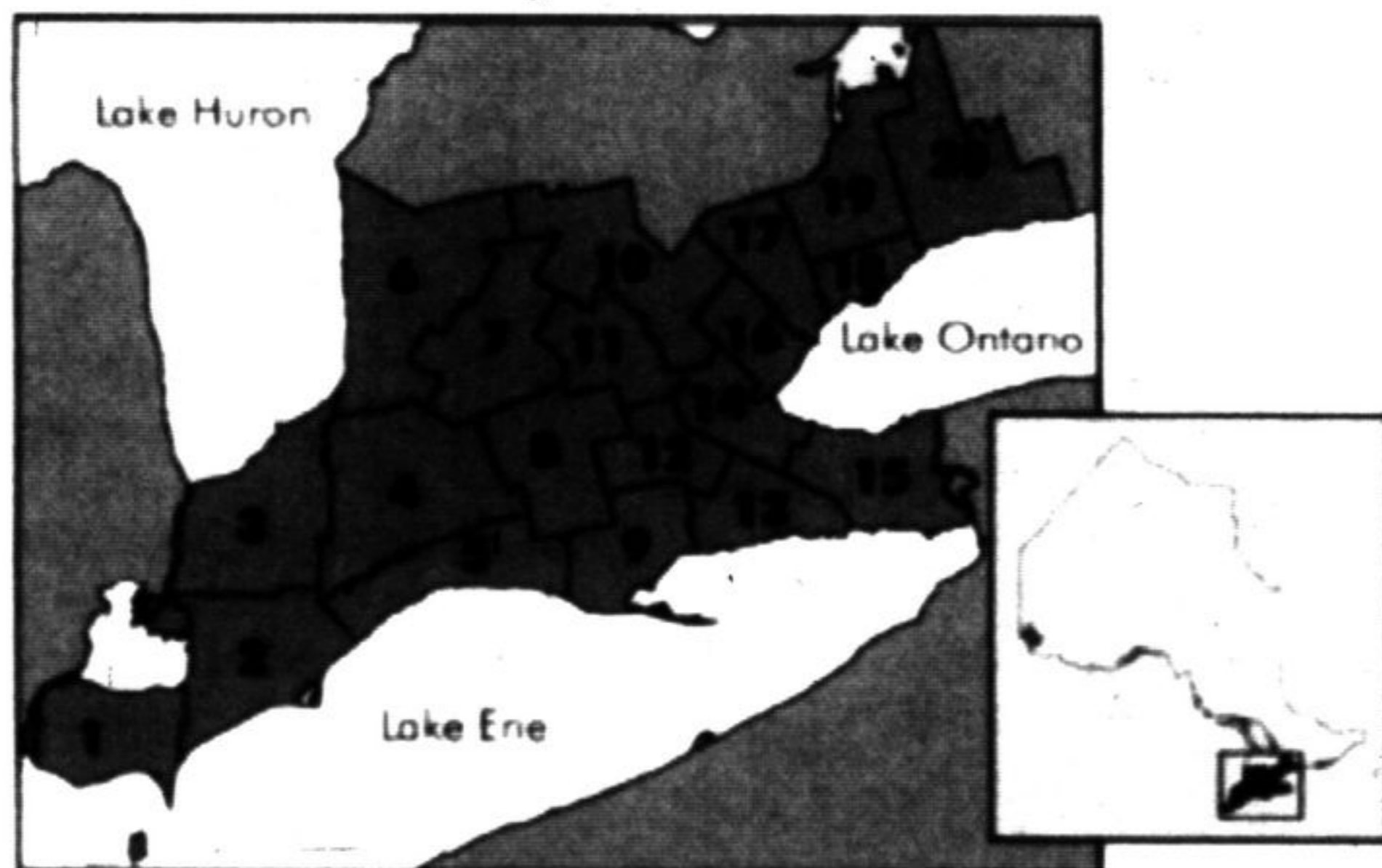

THE EMERALD ASH BORER (EAB) is killing ash trees throughout Ontario. Help protect our trees!

EAB has been detected in southern Ontario. The following counties are in the regulated area: Essex (1), Chatham-Kent (2), Lambton (3), Middlesex (4), Elgin (5), Huron (6), Perth (7), Oxford (8), Norfolk (9), Wellington (10), Waterloo (11), Brant (12), Haldimand (13), Hamilton (14), Niagara (15), Halton (16), Peel (17), Toronto (18), York (19), and Durham (20).

EAB regulated area in southern Ontario



EAB is a destructive insect that spreads to new areas when infested wood is moved.

By federal regulation, anyone moving ash tree materials or firewood out of these 20 counties without written permission from the Canadian Food Inspection Agency may be fined or prosecuted.

Juvenile Clippers remain perfect

The Stouffville Clippers juveniles remained perfect in Ontario Minor Hockey Association home-and-home playdown action after recording a pair of victories last weekend.

Playing host to TNT Friday, the Clippers got off to a good start by scoring the game's first five goals and skated off with a 10-4 win.

Alex Campagna ignited the Clippers' offence with four goals, while Mike Vitelli added two.

Brett Hembruff, Adam Kostandoff, Brett Twizell and Curtis Crago added singles.

Adam Cranley, Vitelli and Damian Gruppuso each collected a pair of helpers while Kostandoff, Ryan Milne, Crago, Twizell and Cody Couperthwaite each had one.

The Clippers carried that momentum into their game against visiting Whitby Sunday and cruised to a 5-2 win.

Campagna, Crago, Twizell, Couperthwaite and Carmen Tisi each scored once for the Clippers, who jumped out to a 3-0 lead after one period and were up 5-2 through two.

Solid goaltending by Kyle Pontone helped preserve the win.

Assists went to Kurt Batty, Couperthwaite, Cranley, Campagna and Twizell.

Now 5-0 in playdown action, the Clippers are scheduled to play in Whitby today.

The Clippers have clinched a semifinal berth and are playing to secure home ice advantage through the playoffs.

The Clippers will host the Ontario Hockey Federation championship tourney April 5 to 7 at the Stouffville Arena.

Teams from the OMHA, Greater Toronto Hockey League, Minor Hockey Alliance of Ontario and Northern Ontario Hockey Association will also take part.
