

Big minor hockey weekend on tap

A celebration of minor hockey will take place in Whitchurch-Stouffville when several tournaments take to the ice this weekend.

While the Stouffville juvenile Clippers will host the Ontario Hockey Federation AAA championships at the Stouffville Arena, the Whitchurch-Stouffville Minor Hockey Association will wrap up its season by conducting their Year Ender Bender Tournament at the Clippers Complex and Stouffville Arena.

Three Clippers' rostered select entries will take to the ice in the novice, atom and pee wee divisions.

The tournament is scheduled to begin at the Clippers Complex Friday at 12:50 p.m. and continue Saturday at 8 a.m.

The finals will be held at the Stouffville Arena Pad B starting at 12:45 p.m. for novice, 2:15 p.m. atom and 3:45 p.m. for pee wee.

Along with this event, the association will conduct the Tyke C Festival at the Stouffville Arena's Pad B surface starting at 5:15 p.m. Friday through Sunday.

A total of six teams will take part including the host Clippers, Markham Waxers, Unionville Jets, Georgina, Richmond Hill Stars and Newmarket Redmen.

The event is slated to wind down with the final Sunday at 11:35 a.m.

The Clippers Complex will also serve as host for the Lakeshore-York Simcoe AE Challenge Sunday.

Scheduled to begin at noon and 1:25 p.m., the event will pit the winners of the York Simcoe titles against the Lakeshore Division from novice AE to minor midget AE.

The host Clippers will field two entries including the major peewees against the Whitby at 5:55 p.m. and minor bantams against Ajax at 4:15 p.m.

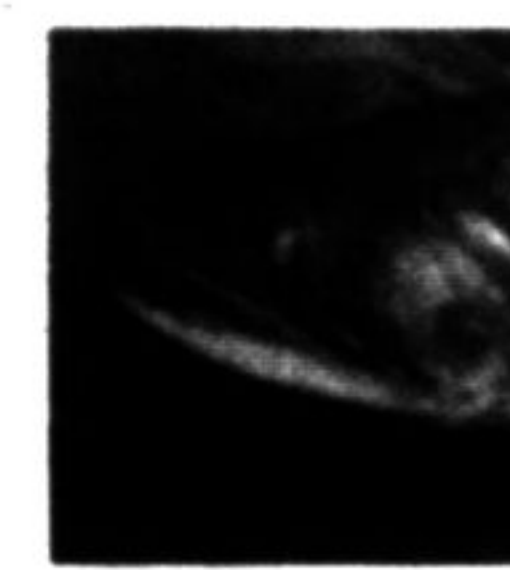

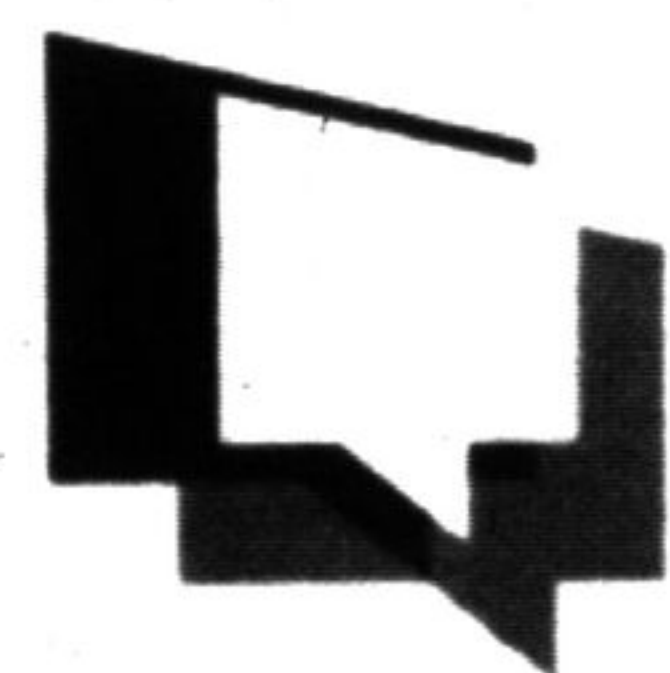
