# Have your say on budget Tuesday

Adult tournaments held on town ball diamonds and soccer pitches may cost organizers an additional \$150 a day if they plan on serving alcohol.

That is just one of the proposed changes to user fees, which will be up for approval Tuesday when the town's 2013 budget is debated.

The meeting starts at 9 a.m. in council chambers and is open to the public, who will have an opportunity to voice their opinions, according to Mayor Wayne Emmerson.

If council cannot agree on a final tax hike by the end of the day, the meeting will continue Wednesday at 9 a.m.

The draft budget proposes a \$96 increase in residential taxes on homes assessed at \$575,000.

The town's portion of the proposed hike is \$60, while the region claims \$36.

Other new user fees put forth include a \$50 per licence plate replacement charge for ice cream and mobile vendors, as well as for refreshment vehicles and taxis.

A \$25 charge for the removal or date change of a post-dated cheque submitted to the municipality will apply, if approved.

A one-time \$50 fee may be enacted on the creation of a new MPAC account. This is often

charged to the developer, but sometimes also to the first buyer of the home, according to a town presentation.

The rental of small and large multi-purpose rooms by non-residents could go from \$40 an hour to \$175 per day (small multi-purpose) and \$50 per hour to \$350 a day (large multi purpose).

### Setting off fireworks? You may now have to visit fire chief

If you want to set off fireworks you must first get permission from the fire chief.

Unless, of course, it is on Victoria Day, Canada Day or the two days immediately preceding or following each of the holidays. The bylaw already allows for that.

Prior to council approving the recommendation from staff, written permission had to be obtained from council.

The change was made to create a more efficient process for residents, according to the council report.
