Boys born in 1999 or later are eligible for this team, which will begin outdoor play in York Region. Players should bring indoor shoes and shin pads.

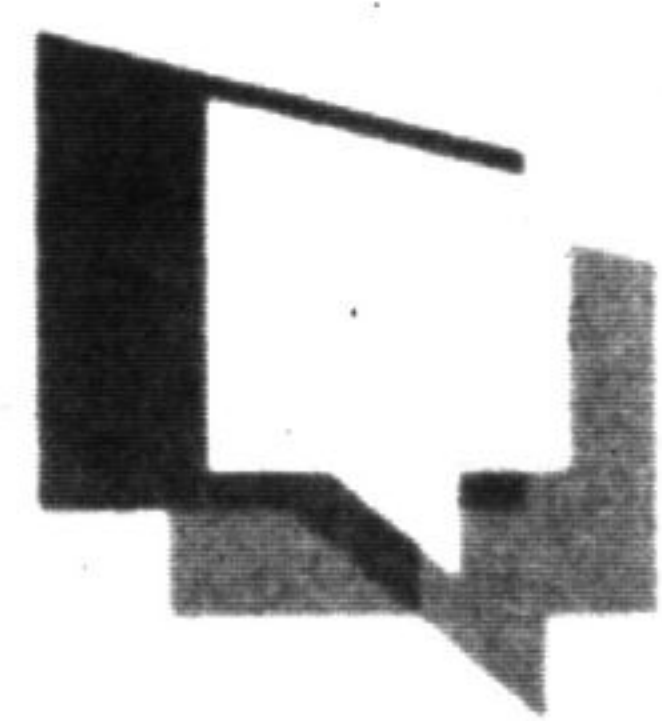
The Mustangs have just wrapped up their winter indoor season with a 2-1 win this past Saturday over Richmond Hill.
