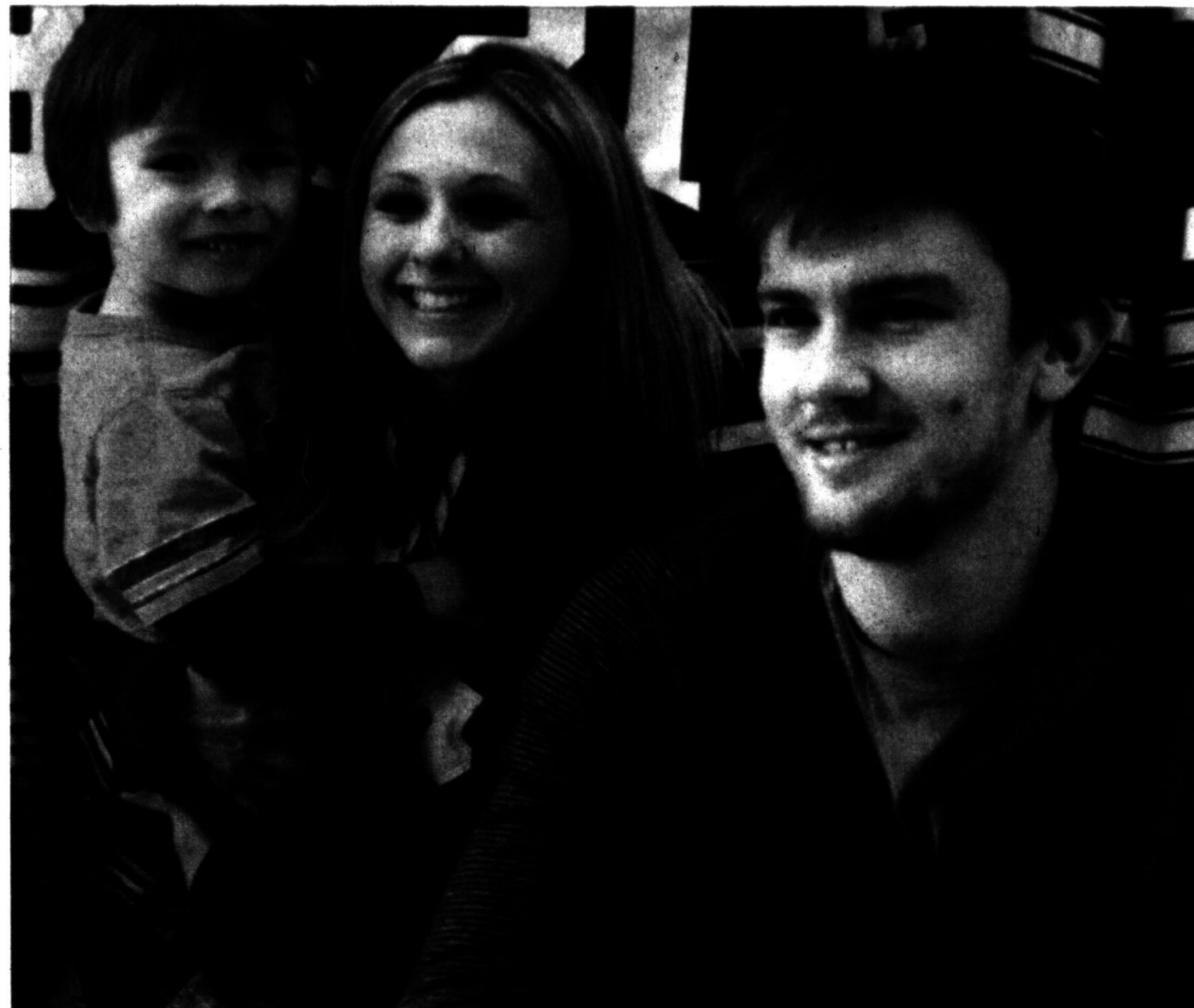


Gotta Be-Leaf
