Please note these important garbage and recycling (Blue Box) restrictions.

- no containers/contents weighing over 22 kg
- no containers over 125 litres (similar to photo)
- no loose grocery/kitchen catcher bags
- no cardboard boxes

Recycling materials will only be collected in molded rigid open top containers (no lids or nets) not exceeding 65cm in length, 50cm in width and 50cm in height.

Cardboard must be broken down to 90cm x 90cm x 30cm. Newspaper and boxboard bundled and tied may be placed next to the blue box for collection.
