The sold-out event took place at the Flato Markham Theatre and was hosted by Canadian country music legend Charlie Major.

"There is a lot of talent out there," he said. "And a lot of those are from right here in Ontario."

The night's first award went to Marylynne and Brad Stella of the Stellas for best group or duo of the year.

The Whitby couple has written and sang country-pop songs for more than 15 years and toured with the likes of Johnny Reid and Terri Clark.

The duo recently signed on to tour with the Zac Brown Band this summer.

"This is incredible," the mother of two said.

Backstage, the winning jitters didn't die down, either.

"When I heard our name, I was like, 'What?'," she said. "I'm still shocked. This is the coolest prize. It's a piece of history. The very first CMAO award, I still can't believe it."

The award is a silver star hoisted on a platform.

And it is fitting the Stellas took home the accolade, since stella is Italian for star, she added.

Prior to accepting the award, the pair was backstage rehearsing their lines as presenters for an award later in the show.

"They called our name and I was ready to present the award to someone else."

The duo releases their next single this summer with a new album to follow in the fall.

It was the Good Brothers of Richmond Hill and Newmarket who pre-

"We are the first cowboy hats on stage tonight," said Bruce Good, who is also the association board's second vice-president, adding it was an honour to present the first award.

The association started several years ago and the awards took about a year's worth of work, Mr. Good

The inaugural ceremony awarded artists, albums and songs between 2009 and 2012.

"I woke up for the first time in weeks with nothing to do," he said. "The board has worked so hard. An awards ceremony is definitely in the cards for next year."

Mr. Good, along with his twin brother, Brian, and younger brother. Larry, have been on the country music scene for more than 40 years.

The packed theatre was privy to a lineup of talented performers including Deric Ruttan, Michelle Wright, Jason Blaine, Charlie Major, Small Town Pistols, Kira Isabella as well as special performances from Greg Keelor of Blue Rodeo together with Travis Good of the Sadies' and the Good Brothers.

"This show is about provincial pride," Mr. Good said. "Many people think the heart of Canadian country music is Calgary or Edmonton, but a lot of new talent is coming out of Ontario. We have a hat full of artists, here."

Over the past several years, the association has established outreach programs for Ontario country singers and songwriters, hosted country music panels featuring agents and producers, and hosted demo-ramas, where artists are professionally critiqued on their demo tapes.
