Town honours victims of ORNGE helicopter crash

In honour of the four ORNGE air ambulance personnel who lost their lives last week, the flags were lowered to half-mast Tuesday at the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville's two fire stations.

Investigators say the helicopter took off from the runway in Moosonee Friday night, made a left-hand turn, went into some trees and started descending down to the ground fast.

The air ambulance was en route to Attiwapiskat, where a patient was waiting for transport. The cause of the crash is still under investigation.

Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville councillors and fire and emergency services' staff extended condolences to family, friends and fellow emergency services professionals for their loss.
