# Free munchies at movie series opener

It will be another summer of Friday night movies under the stars.

The outdoor movie series returns June 28 with *Surf's Up*. Show time is dusk. It's also opening night for the Whitchurch-Stouffville Strawberry Festival.

All of this year's movies will be screened in Memorial Park's former outdoor pool location.

Popcorn and other treats will be free June 28 but available for a fee the rest of the summer, according to Maria Schembri, spokesperson for the town.

Last year, between 350 and 500 people attended each of the screenings.

This year's line up is: *Despicable Me* (July 5), *Premium Rush* (July 12), *E.T.* (July 19), *Brave* (July 26), *Field of Dreams* (Aug. 2), *The Odd Life of Timothy Green* (Aug. 9), *The Little Rascals* (Aug. 16), *Hotel Transylvania* (Aug. 23) and *Gnomeo and Juliet* (Aug. 30).

## Charitable fun run/walk returns

More than 70 people participated in and raised \$3,500 in last year's inaugural Join IN Family 5K Run/Walk.

This year's event takes place June 30, 9:30 a.m. from the Stouffville Clippers Sports

Complex, 120 Weldon Rd. It is not an officially timed race.

All proceeds go to the municipality's Join IN program, which helps cover registration fees for recreational and cultural programs of some residents.

"The fund supports residents of all ages and assists in removing the barriers to make culture and recreation opportunities available to all," according to the town's media release.

In 2012, the Join IN program spent about \$5,000 enabling residents to participate in town programs or those of the Latcham Gallery, Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library, 55+ Club and the Lebovic Centre for Arts & Entertainment - Nineteen on the Park, according to the media release.

Registration is \$20 for adults and \$10 for youth or \$40 for a family. You can also register race day. The adult fee is \$25 and the youth cost is \$15.

All participants receive a T-shirt and finish line shower courtesy of the fire department's aerial truck.

On-site event facilities include showers, washrooms and special needs' adult change tables. All-terrain wheelchairs are available but must be booked in advance.
