SUPPLEMENTARY TAXES ON **NEWLY-CONSTRUCTED HOMES**

Once assessed, supplementary tax bills will be issued for the house, retroactive to the date of possession. To estimate the annual taxes, simply multiply the purchase price of the home x1 per cent. This process can take two to three years and the tax bills will be due within a short time period. Pre-payments or a pre-authorized payment plan can be made to assist homeowners in planning for these future supplementary tax bills.
