

Mennos win B title at Tom Sims fastball tourney

The Stouffville Mennos captured the B Division title at the 49th annual Tom Sims fastball tournament with a 5-1 victory over host Meaford.

Mennos' pitcher Jay Nesbitt surrendered just three hits to earn the win.

Shawn Boadway and Dale Boadway supplied the bulk of the Mennos' offence as each collected a pair of hits and had two RBIs.

Opening the tournament against Orangeville, the Mennos received a solid one-hit pitching performance from Nesbitt, only to suffer a heart-breaking 1-0 loss.

Rich Burkholder and Jeff Boadway had one hit apiece to account for the Mennos' offence.

Facing the Keady Jets in their sec-

ond game, the Mennos rebounded with a 5-2 win.

Mennos' pitcher Greg Dalgarno limited the Jets to just four hits to earn the win.

Dale Boadway led the offence with a home run, double and triple while Rich Burkholder added two singles and a double.

Any momentum gained from that win was lost in their third game as the Mennos suffered a 3-1 loss to Elmwood.

Faisal Hassan scored the only run for Stouffville on a single by Cam Western.

Nesbitt took the loss.

With the round-robin segment ending in a three-way tie for second place and based on runs allowed over the three games, the Mennos advanced to the B division playoffs.

In the semifinals the Mennos received a three-hit pitching per-

formance from Dalgarno in a 1-0 win over Williamsford.

Shawn Boadway had two hits and Dalgarno drove in the only run of the game.

The Mennos moved from the Oshawa City and District Fastball League to a Richmond Hill loop this season.

Tourney proceeds target brain stem cancer

Andrew Garnet wants to raise the awareness of Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma.

Knowing Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma is an aggressive form of

brain stem cancer, Garnet is doing his part by raising funds through a charity golf event named in honour of his late cousin Ryan Chisim, after he succumbed to this disease in January at the age of 12.

Last year's event raised close to \$20,000 for Sick Kids with funds going directly to the first-ever Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma research fund.

The second annual Ryan Chisim Charity Golf Tournament is scheduled to take place at the Meadowbrook Golf and Country Club Sept. 9.

"The median overall survival of children with this diagnosis is approximately nine months," Garnet, who serves on the tournament's executive committee, said. "As the cancer continues to attack the brain stem, children often lose their motor function, resulting in partial paralysis, loss of voice, sight

and ending with inability to eat and breathe.

"It is in (Ryan's) his memory that we continue to help fight this battle by continuing to raise funds to continue research to find better treatment and hopefully a cure for this very aggressive form of brain stem cancer."

During last year's event, Garnet said they received plenty of support from various sponsors including Audi Richmond Hill.

As well, Stouffville resident and three-time Olympic trampoline medallist Karen Cockburn attended.

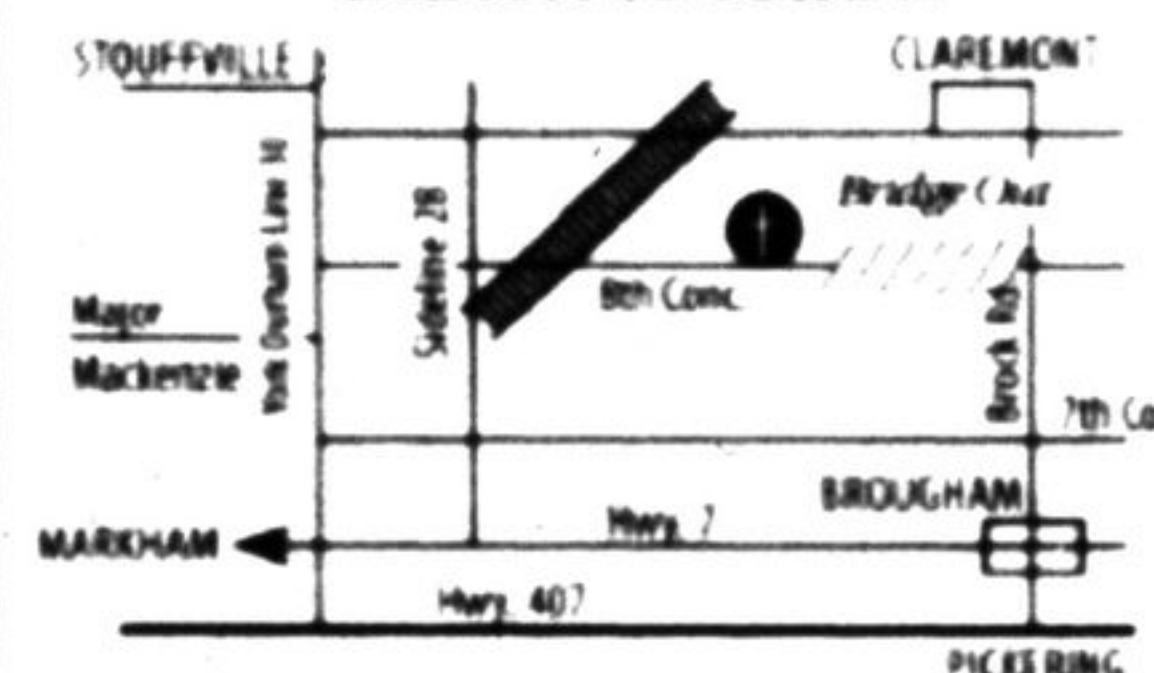
