

Sheffield student-instructor bronzed at World Police Games

Garry Vosburg, a competitor and instructor at the Stouffville-based Sheffield Judo Club, won a bronze medal in the men's 50-59 under-90 kilogram division at the World Police and Fire Games in Belfast, Northern Ireland last week.

For Vosburg, a York Regional Police officer, the medal was his first in several trips to the games.

Vosburg won his first match over Anthony Best of the United Kingdom.

He then lost matches against Yuri Presnov, a second dan from Russia and Shou-Chung Chang, a seventh dan from Chinese Taipei, on penalty points.

On a separate note, the Sheffield club will be relocating to its own, larger facility at 118 Sandiford Dr., Unit 3 Monday.

Aarje Sheffield, co-owner and instructor, said the move will allow for possible expansion. The club had been sharing space with a local dance centre.

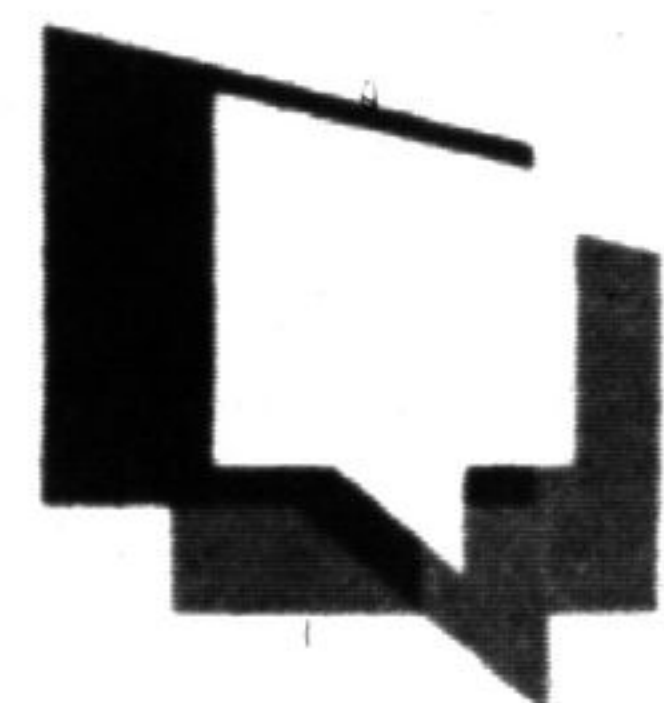
