York Region invites residents and visitors of all ages to participate in a geocaching adventure on **Saturday, August 24 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.** The event will be held in the York Regional Forest (The Eldred King Tract) located at 16232 Highway 48 in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville (South of Highway 48 and Vivian Road).

Geocaching is a fun, outdoor treasure hunting game. To play, participants use Global Positioning System (GPS) enabled devices to find hidden containers called geocaches. In this game, the geocaches will contain code words that solve a secret puzzle. Participants who solve the puzzle or find one or more code words will be eligible to win a prize.
