Mennos finish first, earn bye after moving to new league

The Stouffville Mennos will commence postseason action in the Richmond Hill Men's Fastball League at Richmond Hill Town Park today at 7 p.m.

Finishing the regular season atop the standings with a 10-1-1 mark, the Mennos received a first-round bye. They begin a best-of-three semifinal series tonight.

The second game is slated to be played Sept. 10.

A third game, if required, would be played Sept. 12.

Hathaway 25th at Mosport

The Stouffville-based EHR Team Three Red racing team's quest to

Red finished well back of the pack in 25th place in a scheduled 51-lap race that went just 42 due to a series of incidents.

There were six in total, which was a record in the series, including the final one that was a multi-car accident in Turn 8 that produced a prolonged cleanup.

Combined with time constraints, that incident forced the race to conclude under a yellow-

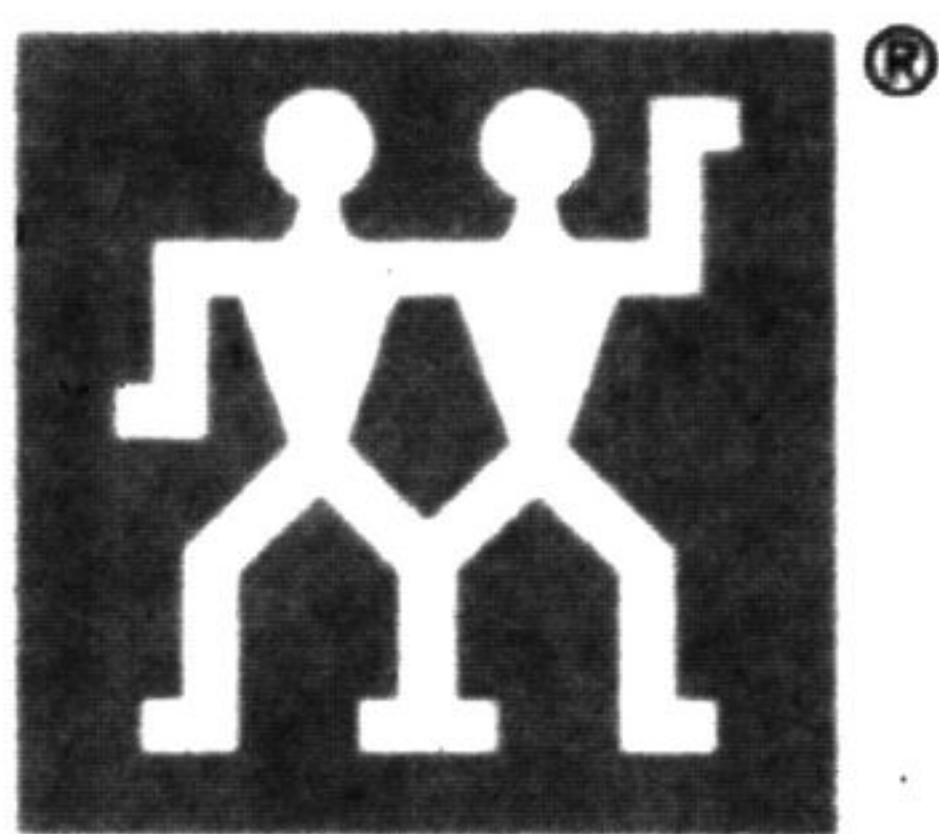
checked finish. L.P. Dumoulin took the checkered flag.

With two races remaining, Hathaway dropped a spot to fourth place in the overall series standings with 360 points.

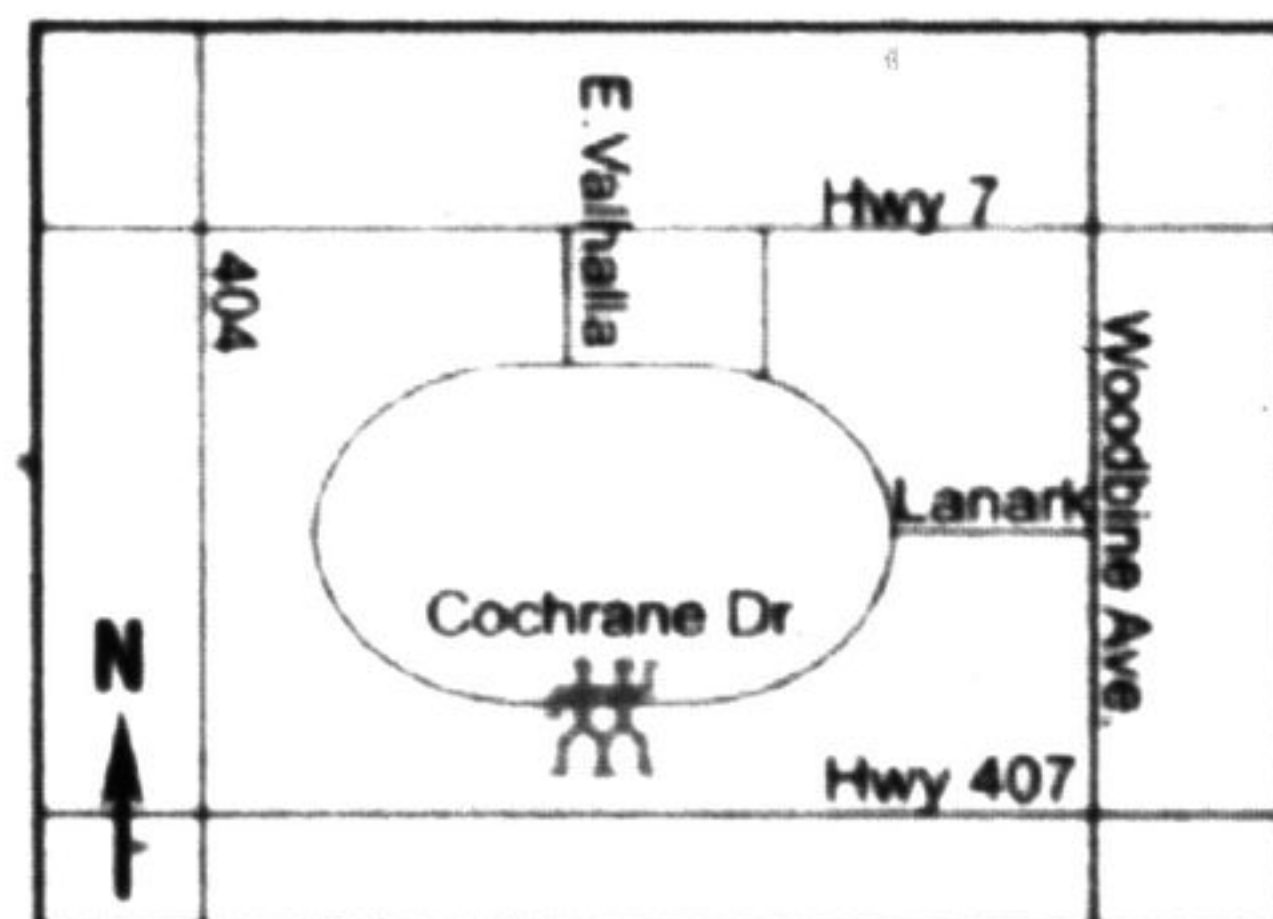
