

Hathaway wins again, heads to NASCAR final

It took five years for Jason Hathaway to capture his first NASCAR Canadian Tire Series North event earlier this year at Riverside, N.S.

But for the Stouffville-based EHR Team Three Red driver to get his second checkered flag in the series while driving the Snap-on Tools/Rockstar Energy Drink Dodge, it happened far faster – just three weeks later.

Taking to the Barrie Speedway .333-mile tri-oval for the Hudco Electric Supply 300 presented by G-Oil, Hathaway made a late surge to overtake D.J. Kennington for the win Sunday.

With the race originally scheduled for Saturday, persistent rainfall in the area forced qualifying and the main race to take place the following day.

EHR Team Three Red crew chief Craig Masters and car chief Graham Annis felt patience would be the key, noting Barrie Speedway has gained a reputation for its wrecks along with the beating and banging vehicles take.

By lap 43, Hathaway, who qualified in sixth place, moved up to third spot. He took the lead on lap 79.

The crew topped off Hathaway's fuel and made a quick chassis adjustment on lap 89, under caution. He went back out in second spot and it wasn't four laps after the green flag flew that he was back leading the field.

Taking on new tires on lap 145, Hathaway worked his way back from eighth place into the top three.

After several restarts, Hathaway took command of the field for the last time on lap 284 when he overtook Kennington in the 303-lap race that concluded in a green-white-checkered flag finish.

"I am so proud of our team and of all of the support we get from our sponsors and families," Hathaway said. "We said we would battle back after the finish last weekend (a 25th place result at the Clarington 200) and that is exactly what we did."

"Graham (Annis) and Craig (Masters) made some great calls and I was happy with our car pretty much all day. We came here prepared to win and we did just that," he said.

Hathaway is in third place in the series standings with 408 points. Kennington holds down top spot with 430. Scott Steckly is second with 425.

The series championship will be decided in the season finale Sept. 21 at the Pinty's 250 at Kawartha Speedway in Peterborough.

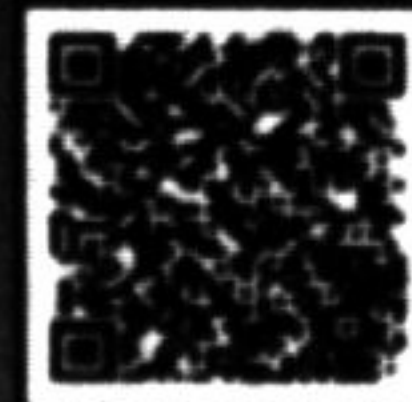
