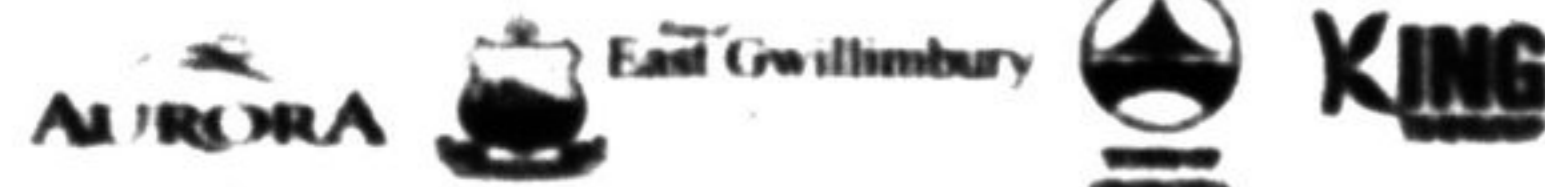


Not all types of plastic are recyclable in your blue box.

Leafs send Sam Carrick to Marlies, Canes ship Trevor to Mississauga

Sam Carrick will be starting the 2013-14 hockey season with the Toronto Marlies of the American Hockey League.

The 21-year-old Stouffville resident was among 14 players the parent Toronto Maple Leafs trimmed from their training camp roster Tuesday.

A fifth round pick of the Maple Leafs in the 2010 National Hockey League entry draft, the six-foot, 188-pound forward spent part of last season with the Marlies and compiled two goals and two assists in 19 regular season games.

Carrick began last season with the Idaho Steelheads of the East Coast Hockey League and scored 16 goals and added 21 assists in

50 regular season games before joining the Marlies.

His brother, Trevor, was returned to the Mississauga Steelheads of the Ontario Hockey League by the Carolina Hurricanes Sunday.

Trevor, 19, was a fourth round pick of the Canes in the 2012 NHL draft.

He's entering his third year in Mississauga after a solid season with the Jr. A Stouffville Spirit.

Their older brother, Jake, is entering his third season with the Lakehead University Thunderwolves in Thunder Bay. The 22-year-old played four seasons in the OHL, with Sault Ste. Marie and Windsor.

The youngest brother, Josh, is entering his rookie season in the OHL with the Barrie Colts.

The 17-year-old played for the Spirit last season.

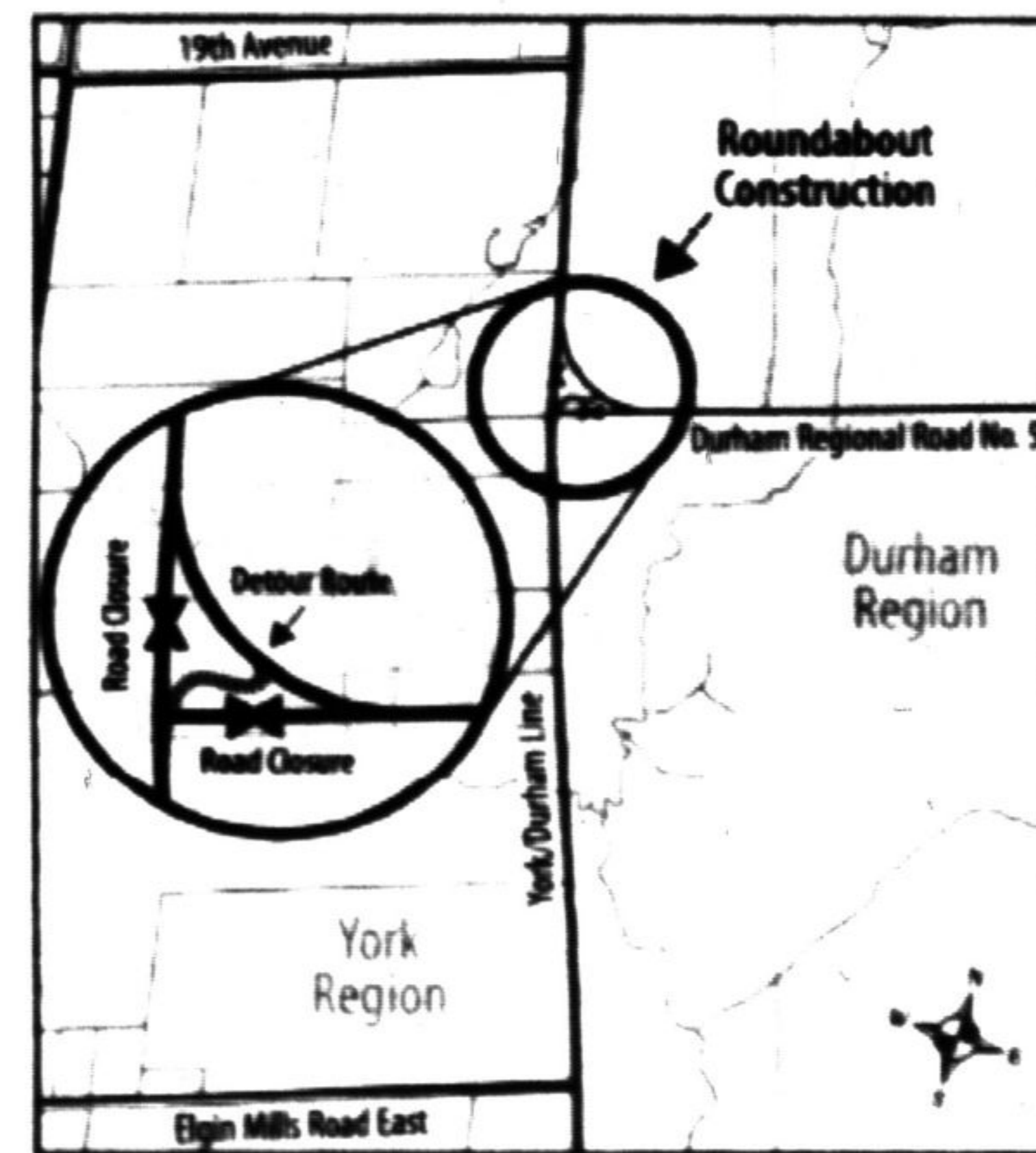
