


# Ban on ice cream truck tunes lifted

That iconic music signaling the arrival of the ice cream truck will be allowed to play every summer from now on.

The bylaw change was approved by council Tuesday afternoon following a summerlong pilot project.

Back in April, James Tziortzis, owner of the Mister Treats Ice Cream truck, went before council requesting the bylaw prohibiting the use of chimes by refreshment vehicles be repealed.

"...this bylaw prohibits my ability to reach the target market I am attempting to attract, all while hindering my business' overall success", he wrote in his deputation documentation to council.

No one in Whitchurch-Stouffville has been able to hear that music since 2005 when the town passed a bylaw prohibiting the use of chimes by vendors, such as refreshment vehicles.

The bylaw was put in place due to complaints, Mayor Wayne Emmerson told council in April.

During the pilot project, no comments or complaints were received by the town, according to the Sept. 17 report to council.

The bylaw now states, in part, that no ice cream truck driver shall "play amplified sounds between the hours of 8 p.m. and 10 a.m. or for more than 20 seconds while stopped at any one location."
