# Will Acton making case to stick with Edmonton Oilers

Will Acton is making a case for earning employment this season with the National Hockey League's Edmonton Oilers.

The 26-year-old Stouffville resident and former Stouffville Spirit and Clipper forward scored the game-winning goal in the second period on a tip-in to propel the Oilers to a 2-1 win over the Winnipeg Jets in an exhibition tilt in Edmonton Monday.

For Acton, the goal marked the second straight game in which he's lit the red light.

The son of Oilers' associate coach Keith Acton, Will played the last two seasons with the Toronto Marlies of the American Hockey League — under new Oilers head coach Dallas Eakins.

Last season, he had eight goals and 11 assists in 67 regular season

As for trying to make the NHL club, Acton said he's just concentrating on trying to play to the best of his ability.

"I'm just trying to stick to the basics and execute our game plan," he said on the Oilers' website after Monday's contest.

"I'm trying to focus in on what I have to do to improve every day

The Oilers, who wrap up their preseason schedule tomorrow, open the regular season at home to the Winnipeg Jets Tuesday.

Will was less than a year old when his dad was on the 1988 Oilers Stanley Cup championship team.

He was bypassed in the NHL and Ontario Hockey League drafts.

# **Knee injury shelves Torres**

Raffi Torres will be starting his 2013-14 National Hockey League season as a member of the San Jose Sharks in the stands.

For the 31-year-old Stouffville resident, it isn't by choice.

He incurred a knee injury that could put him on the shelf anywhere from six weeks to four months.

The incident took place when the Sharks played the Anaheim Ducks in a preseason game last Friday, resultingin a 3-2 overtime loss.

During the game, the veteran forward collided with Emerson Etem and was diagnosed with an ACL injury.

If Torres does not have surgery, he could be out six weeks.

Should Torres go under the knife, he could be out three to four months.

Acquired from the Phoenix Coyotes part way through last season, Torres had two goals and four assists in 11 games with the Sharks.


Signed to a three-year, \$6 million contract extension earlier this year, Torres was a former first-round pick of the New York Islanders during the 2000 NHL entry draft.


The 22-year-old Goodwood resident and former Stouffville Spirit forward played the last two seasons with the Pirates.
