

## Stouffville car finishes third in NASCAR series

The Stouffville-based EHR-Team Three Red racing team had their sights set on trying to win the final NASCAR Canadian Tire Series race of the season and overall point series championship when they took to the Kawartha Speedway oval at the Pinty's 250 near Fraserville Sunday.

Unfortunately, their hopes were dashed when Jason Hathaway and the Snap-on Tools/Rockstar Energy Drink Dodge encountered misfortune during the race — which was rescheduled from Saturday due to rain — when he was involved in an untimely incident late in the race and finished 11th.

Hathaway finished third in the overall series standings.

Hathaway, who began the 250-lap event in the 11th position, worked his way back up to second.

His run was interrupted on lap 217 when an ill handling lapped car spun him out.

Scott Steckly won the race and took the overall championship point standing title with 473 points.

D.J. Kennington was second with 471 points and Hathaway third 442.

"We had a car that could have finished on the podium here today (Sunday), but being spun by a lapped car really took that out of our grasp," Hathaway said. "We have definitely spiced up the points battle in 2013 and we made some huge

### College coach offers tips

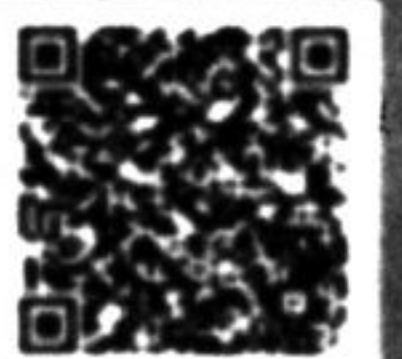

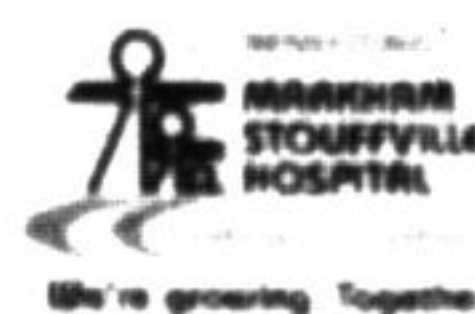
