Expansion plans on agenda

The town is hosting a public information centre on its growth management strategy Oct. 16.

Residents will be able to view the draft development concept, staff will provide information on the planning process and obtain input.

In order to meet the targets set out by the region of 23,000 jobs and 60,600 residents by 2031, the municipality has to develop its phase three lands within urban Stouffville and undergo moderate intensification.

The phase three lands are within Stouffville but are not serviced. They are located just south of Bethesda Road and run from York-Durham Line to just west of Hwy. 48.

As part of the phase three land development, the town is prepping a secondary plan and related servicing and transportation master plans for those lands.

The meeting runs from 7 to 9 p.m. in the council chambers, 111 Sandiford Dr.


