COUNCIL ADOPTS VOTING METHOD FOR 2014 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Whitchurch-Stouffville Town Council approved the voting method for the 2014 municipal election to be in-person voting using vote count tabulators for the Advance Vote and on Voting Day.

YORK REGION TO BUILD FOREST STEWARDSHIP & EDUCATION CENTRE IN WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE

Whitchurch-Stouffville Town Council approved a Site Plan Control Agreement exemption to allow the construction of the York Region Forest Stewardship & Education Centre at 16389 Highway 48 (Hollidge Forest Tract). The new building will provide a wide range of environmental programs and events in areas such as forestry management, source water protection, invasive species and management practices.

SANITARY SEWER TO BE INSTALLED AT NINTH LINE AND MAIN STREET

Mardave Construction (2007) Ltd. has been exempted from the Town's Noise Bylaw to facilitate the construction of a sanitary sewer at the intersection of Main Street and Ninth Line. Construction will proceed continuously from **Friday, October 25 to Monday, October 28**.

COUNCIL EXTENDS SITE PLAN CONTROL AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SENIORS' APARTMENT BUILDING

A Site Plan Control Agreement for 2060332 Ontario Ltd. to permit the construction of a seniors' apartment building at 465-481 Rupert Avenue has been extended for one year to allow the development to proceed. Whitchurch-Stouffville Town Council approved the extension of this agreement with an amendment to address concerns relating to the maintenance and management of the property. The amendment will allow Town staff to detail specific provisions for site improvement security.

SCHOOL BUS SAFETY

Motorists travelling on a Town, Region and undivided provincial highway must stop in both directions when approaching a stopped school bus with its upper red lights flashing. A flashing stop arm will swing out while passengers are boarding or leaving the bus. Do not start moving until the stop arm has folded away, the lights have stopped flashing and the bus begins to move. Drivers can be charged if their vehicle illegally passes a stopped school bus. The first offence is \$400 to \$1,000 and six demerit points.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION - RESURFACING Commencing Tuesday, October 15

Warden Avenue - Aurora Road to Vivian Road

YARD WASTE/LEAF COLLECTION

Place Curbside on Your Collection Day By 7 a.m.

Residents are advised that leaves will only be collected if they are in paper bags or reusable open top containers (excluding cardboard boxes) such as bushel baskets or garbage cans. **Plastic bags will not be collected.** Other materials accepted for collection include leaves, plants, fine brush, tree clippings and branches up to 100 mm (four inches) in diameter and tied in bundles of a maximum length of 1.2 metres (four feet) and weighing no more than 22 kgs (fifty pounds). The Town does not pick up leaves raked, blown or piled along the roads.
