

SDSS grad finishes 20th in Washington race

Michael Bourgeois ran his way to a 20th place finish in the men's division at the 40th annual Western Washington University Cross Country Classic in Bellingham, Wash. Saturday.

The 20-year-old Ballantrae resident and Stouffville District Secondary School graduate who attends the University of British Columbia completed the 10-kilometre course in 32:54.

Majoring in kinesiology, the former high school standout also helped his UBC men's team finish second in the men's eight-team competition behind the host school.

Sivabalasingham ninth at U of T golf invitational

Gajan Sivabalasingham was part of a University of Waterloo Warriors men's golf team that finished fourth at the University of Toronto Invitational held at Angus Glen Golf Course in Unionville Friday.

The 19-year-old Ballantrae resident who is in his third year led the Warriors' contingent after carding a three-over 75 on the club's North Course.

That placed Sivabalasingham in a six-way tie for ninth place overall in the eight-team event.

Phil Arci, a Woodbridge resident who attends the University of Toronto, won the individual event with a three-under 69.

Minor hockey goalies get help from new mentor

Entering the 2013-14 minor hockey season, officials with the Whitchurch-Stouffville Minor Hockey Association wanted to find a way to develop their goaltenders.

They think they have taken the steps to do just that with the recent appointment of Carson Bird to the position of goaltender mentor.

Bird will be responsible for the association's Goaltender Training

and Development Program for house league and rep goalies.

He will also continue to be responsible for association-sponsored goalie clinics, which are designed to supplement the efforts of house league and rep coaches.

The house league clinics, which are free, are scheduled to run at the Stouffville Arena, Pad B starting Oct. 27 and Nov. 3 for one hour beginning at 9:15 a.m. for tykes B and C, novice and atom netminders.

For peewee and bantam house league goalkeepers, the clinics will run Nov. 10, 17 and 24.

Bird will also provide periodic progress reports to coaches and goaltenders based on his observations from games and clinics.

He will also be available to

coaches and goaltenders for on and off-ice consultation and assistance as requested.

"Carson has been increasingly involved with both our house league and rep goalie training over the past couple of years," said Ron Bremner, an association board member.

"The goalies seem to relate very well to Carson and we've seen some pretty positive signs in terms of the depth and quality of our goaltenders. The board felt it was simply a logical next step to give him more scope to develop and implement a goaltending strategy for the association."
