Water Pollution Control Plant**

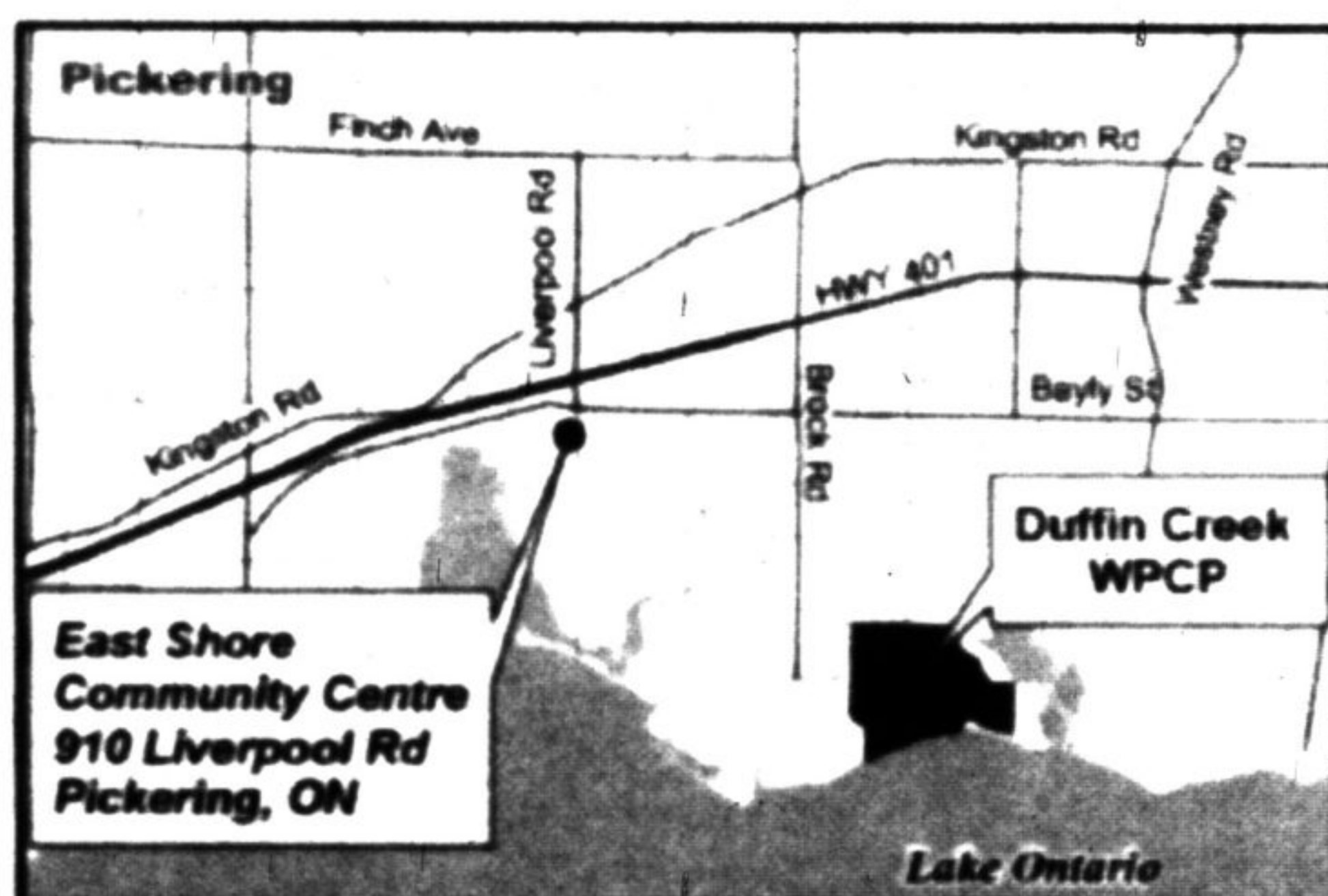


NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION FORUM # 4

The Regional Municipalities of Durham and York are jointly undertaking a Schedule C Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Study (Class EA) to identify the preferred solution for addressing the future capacity limitations of the existing outfall at the Duffin Creek Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP). The first two Public Information Forums (PIF) were held in May 2011 and June 2012 to provide information on the Class EA process and alternative solutions. The most recent PIF #3 in February 2013 presented the preliminary preferred solution for addressing outfall capacity limitations. The preferred solution is to modify the existing outfall with variable diffuser ports, and to optimize existing operations. To receive input from interested persons on the evaluation of alternative methods for implementing the preferred solution, and on the long-term planning option of designing a new outfall, Durham and York Regions will be holding Public Information Forum #4 on the following dates in the City of Pickering and the Town of Ajax:
