

# Local students scare up donations for food bank

Some students from Oscar Peterson Public School are hoping Whitchurch-Stouffville residents will hand out something a little extra with the candy this Halloween.

About 20 Grade 6 to 8 students involved in the school's Me to We group will be collecting non-perishable food items for the Whitchurch-Stouffville Food Bank.

It's part of their We Scare Hunger campaign.

Me to We is affiliated with Feed The Children, which was founded in 1995 by Craig Kielburger to empower a generation to shift the world from 'me' to 'we' through, in part, how one acts and gives, according to the organization's website.

"Word of mouth is how things are going to change," said Shanyl McIntyre, a reading recovery and English language learner teacher at Oscar Peterson. She is also the school's Me to We facilitator.

The food drive will continue through to

Nov. 8 at the school. The goal is for the entire student body to bring in 3,000 non-perishable food items. The school has about 600 students, according to Ms McIntyre.

To help with the food drive, the student's Halloween dance and fun house admission fees are each by donation of a non-perishable food item.

The evening, which starts at 5:30 p.m., is presented by the BGCC social committee.

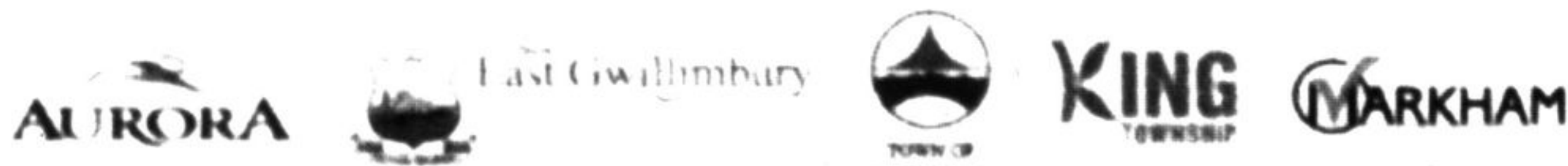
