GAME NOTES: Despite coming out on the short end of a pair of Ontario Junior Hockey League contests and having their winless streak extended to six games last weekend, you won't hear any complaints from Jeff Perrin. In fact, the Stouffville Spirit head coach was encouraged by the effort in a 6-5 road loss to the Milton IceHawks Friday and a 6-5

shootout loss to the Trenton Golden Hawks at the Stouffville Arena Sunday, which required six shooters. The Spirit took a 1-0 lead through 20 minutes on the first of two goals by rookie forward Tyson Bruce. Both clubs exchanged a pair of goals in the second frame with Nick Thomakos and Michael Morgan scoring for the Spirit that enabled them to maintain a one-goal edge at 3-2 entering the third period. During the final 20 minutes of regulation time, the Golden Hawks got a pair of goals within the opening 90 seconds to take a 4-3 lead. After Bruce scored his second goal of the game on the power play to tie the score, the Golden Hawks countered with a goal, before the Spirit's Christopher Brill-Morgan scored with just under five minutes remaining to tie the

game. The Golden Hawks outshot the Spirit 39-33.

In Friday's road tilt against Milton, the Spirit held a 2-1 lead after the opening 20 minutes on the strength of goals from Robert Powers and Thomakos on the power play. The Spirit maintained a onegoal advantage late in the second period before the IceHawks got goals in the final two minutes to gain the upper hand at 5-4 entering the third period. The Spirit pulled netminder Daniel Mannella for an extra attacker, but the IceHawks scored into the empty net with 98 seconds remaining to take a 6-4 lead. With 35 seconds remaining in the tilt, the Spirit got a goal from Thomakos to get back to within

Perrin also noted veteran forward Daryl Thomson could be back in their lineup by early December after incurring a leg injury before the regular season began. On the collegiate scene, former Spirit defenceman and Stouffville resident Paul Geiger collected a pair of assists in Clarkson University's 4-3 road win over Brown University, Friday. A second-year defenceman, Geiger has one goal and seven assists in 10 games. Former Spirit forward Matt Neal collected a goal and two assists in Rensselaer Polytechnical Institute's 7-1 road win over Dartmouth College, Saturday. Currently in his junior year, Neal has two goals and

six assists in eight games. Stouffville resident and second-year forward Chris Porter earned an assist in American International College's 5-4 road loss against Michigan State University, Friday. After what appeared to be serious injury just one week ago, former Spirit forward Drake Caggiula scored the game's first goal for the University of North Dakota in a 3-2 loss to St. Cloud State, Friday.

GENERALLY SPEAKING: "I thought we played good all weekend," Perrin said. "I thought we deserved more than just one point. But that's the way the game goes.

"We make mistakes, but every team makes them. If no team made mistakes the game would be boring. We've just got to limit our own mistakes."
