Jamie Wise scored a goal and collected two assists to propel the Ryerson University Rams to a 5-1 road win over the Brock University Badgers in OUA action in St. Catharines, Friday.

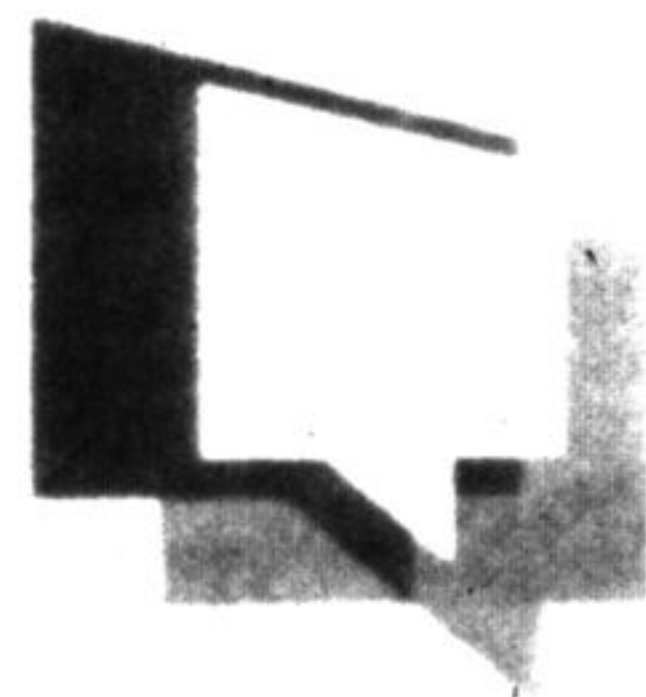
