# Tims in Gormley OK with council

Getting a double-double in Gormley is one step closer to reality.

On Tuesday afternoon, Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville council approved an amendment to the site plan control agreement for a Tim Hortons to be constructed at 12332 Woodbine Ave., just north of the Husky gas station.

It is already under construction.

The Timbit maker's plan to build a restaurant and drive-thru was actually registered in February 2012. But since then, some minor

design changes have been made.

The most notable difference is the drivethru will go from one lane to two, according to the report.

The building will also be 370 square feet larger. Under the town's bylaw, the restaurant can have a maximum seating capacity of 55 people.

An opening date has not yet been released, according to Maria Schembri, town spokesperson.
