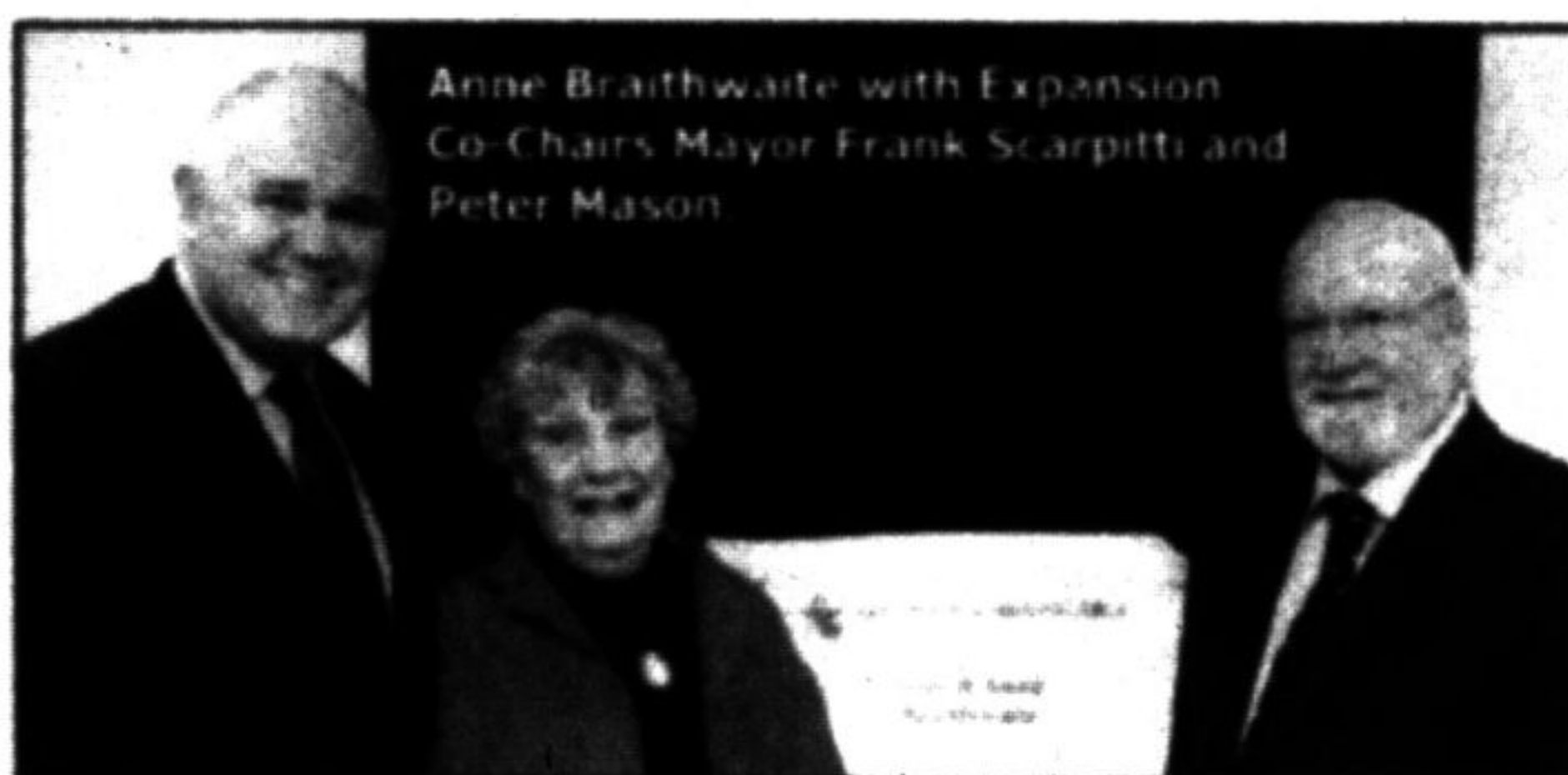

Anne Braithwaite with Expansion Co-Chairs Mayor Frank Scarpitti and Peter Mason

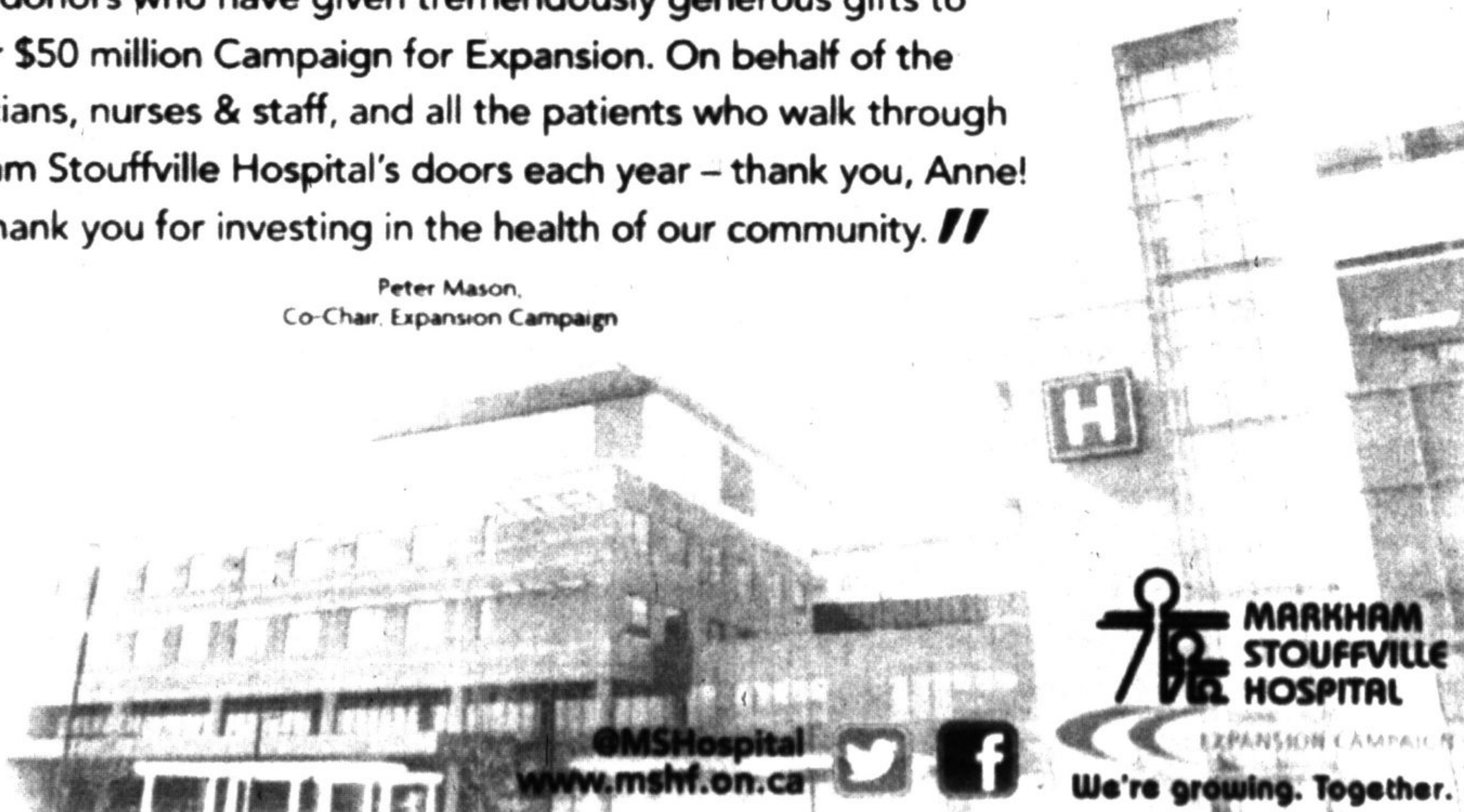
