

COUNCIL: Two weak years on Park Dr.

New location, optimism for farmers' market

The Stouffville Farmers' Market is on the move.

Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville council approved moving the market to the municipal lot next to the Latham Gallery and the former Care and Share Thrift Shop lot at 6240 Main St. Tuesday.

The move comes after the number of vendors and shoppers dropped during last year's market season.

Councillor Phil Bannon said he would have preferred moving the market to Civic Square, in front of the Lebovic Centre for Arts & Entertainment - Nineteen on the Park. But staff and a vendor at the meeting said the area is too small.

The market has been held Thursdays from May through October on or next to Park Drive in Memorial Park during its first five years.

There were four full-time vendors at the market last year.

Councillor Richard Bartley, who was on

the now defunct market committee, argued vendor fees should be waived to bring back more farmers.

But downtown co-ordinator Anna Rose says interest is strong and she expects all booths to be taken and paid for.

A report to council also says the town's decision to broaden sales from the original 100-mile radius around Stouffville to all of Ontario two years ago had a detrimental effect on the market.
