MAIN STREET ROAD CLOSURES FROM MARKET STREET TO PARK DRIVE APPROVED

Whitchurch-Stouffville Town Council approved a series of temporary road closures to accommodate the Summer Street Series events this spring/summer in Downtown Stouffville. The Town will close Market Street to Park Drive on Main Street from 4 p.m. to 10 p.m. on the following days:

- Tuesday, May 13 (Rain date Tuesday, May 20)
Classic Car Show and Benjamin Moore, Paint What Matters program celebration
- Thursday, June 19 (Rain date Friday, June 20)
Latin Dinner and Dance on the street
- Thursday, July 17 (Rain date Friday, July 18)
Good Ole Rock & Roll Dinner and Dance on the street
- Thursday, August 21 (Rain date Friday, August 21)
Moonlight Madness/Murder Mystery on the street

COUNCIL RECEIVES INFORMATION REGARDING PROPOSED ROGERS TELECOMMUNICATIONS TOWER

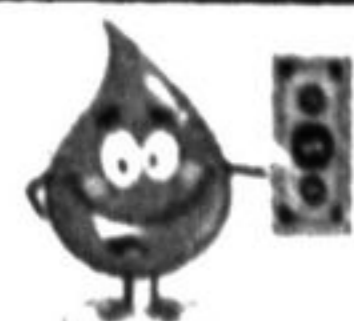
Whitchurch-Stouffville Town Council received a report for the Rogers Communications Inc. Telecommunications Tower proposed to be located at 20 Freel Lane. The Tower would be situated north of Main Street, east of the GO Transit Rail Line and south of the Stouffville Creek Retirement Residence.

Town protocol required the proponent to consult with surrounding landowners, public agencies and residents. A community meeting was hosted by Rogers Communications Inc. at the Lebovic Centre for Arts & Entertainment - Nineteen on the Park on Thursday, January 16. The applicant's response to public comments have been provided to the Town. The applicant has fulfilled the requirements of the Town's Telecommunications Tower Protocol.

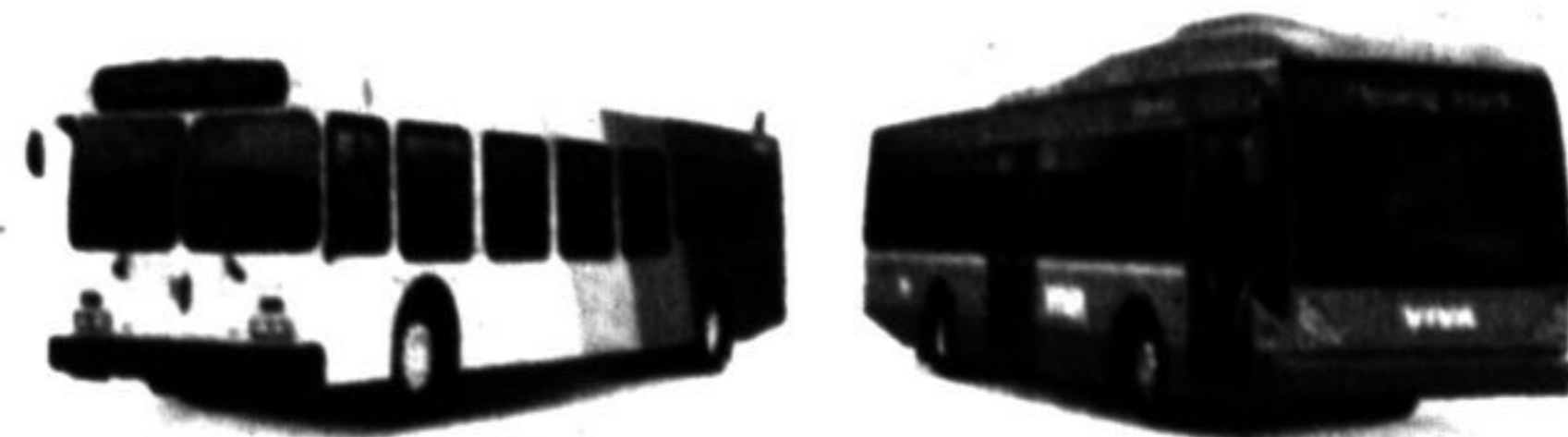

POWER DOWN FOR EARTH HOUR - MARCH 29

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville will join municipalities across the world on **Saturday, March 29** to power down for Earth Hour 2014 from **8:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.** During Earth Hour, The Town will reduce its electricity consumption by turning off all non-essential lights at the Municipal Offices as well as at all Town facilities, maintaining those needed for programs and public safety.

Residents and businesses are encouraged to take part in this initiative by powering down for Earth Hour. Take a walk or play a game by candlelight with friends and family. Don't stop here. Think about what else can be done year-round to reduce your carbon footprint such as taking transit, unplugging unused electrical appliances or even washing your clothes in cold water.

If you are going to use candles during Earth Hour, please try using battery operated candles which will offer the same lighting.
