BOYFRIEND GUILTY OF 2010 GORMLEY MURDER

'Glad we got justice for Marion'

It was a long and drawn out court process followed by a month-long trial filled with gruesome detail for Gord Deacon and his daughters Laura, Amanda and Natasha.

Exactly four years, one month and eight days after the charred and brutally beaten body of Marion Deacon was found on the floor of her Gormley home, in the end, justice was swift.

A mere three hours and 40 minutes after Justice Michelle Fuerst sent the 12 jurors away for deliberation, they returned with a verdict,

that Paul Kenyon, Ms Deacon's former lover, was guilty of second-degree murder.

"I'm glad we got justice for Marion," said Mr. Deacon, her estranged husband who once lived in and has now rebuilt the Doner Street
