Mayor fielding complaints over \$28M centre expansion

Unless the same councillors are sitting behind the dias after Oct. 27 they really have no say about the library/leisure centre expansion, Mayor Wayne Emmerson told the Stouffville Sun-Tribune.

"I don't want to mislead the public. ... We are not making a decision on this but referring it to the new council. ... That is my opinion," he said.

Two public meetings and sessions with the 55+ Club and accessibility advisory group have helped formulate the concept plans for the expansion.

"(The new council) may go back out and totally do the whole thing all over again" or they could shelve the entire project, Mr. Emmerson told The Sun-Tribune.

He told councillors and members of the library board gathered for a workshop on the expansion Tuesday, that perhaps they are

moving too fast.

He added this current council is not finalizing the design, just creating a concept to see if it can fit.

The project is expected to cost \$28 million, which has been put into the 2015 and 2016 budgets, which still require approvals.

Mr. Emmerson has heard from residents it's too expensive, in the wrong location and some of the facilities are not needed, he told attendees.

A report, which includes costing, will go before council June 24.
