

Spirit grad re-signs with Vancouver Canucks

Darren Archibald suited up for 16 games with the Vancouver Canucks last season.

During that time, the 24-year-old Newmarket resident and former Stouffville Spirit forward gave enough of an impression that the National Hockey League club resigned him for the upcoming season Tuesday.

Terms of the deal were not disclosed.

Making his debut with the Canucks last season, Archibald had one goal and two assists. Also logging time with the Canucks' American Hockey League affiliate in Utica, N.Y., Archibald had 10 goals and 12 assists in 59 games with the Utica Comets.

The six-foot, three-inch, 212-pound Archibald played with the Spirit during the 2007-08 campaign and had 21 goals and 27 assists in

49 games.

Other Spirit grads to play in the NHL are Mike Duco (Vancouver, Florida), Chris Tanev (Vancouver) and Will Acton (Edmonton).

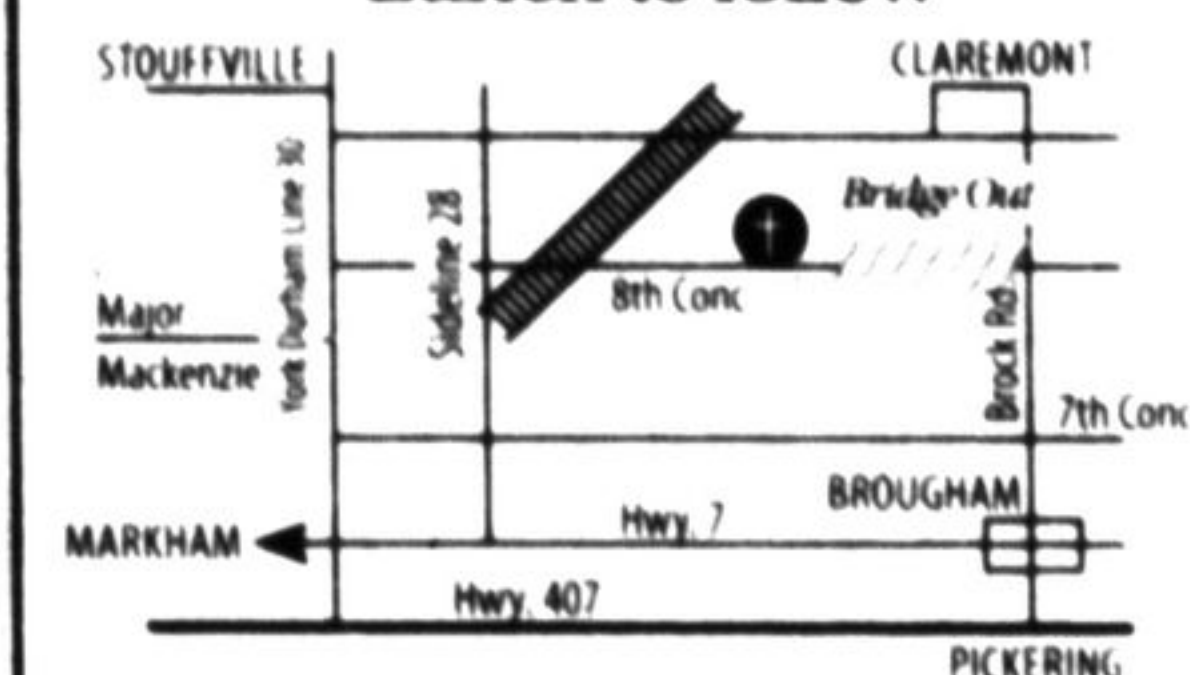

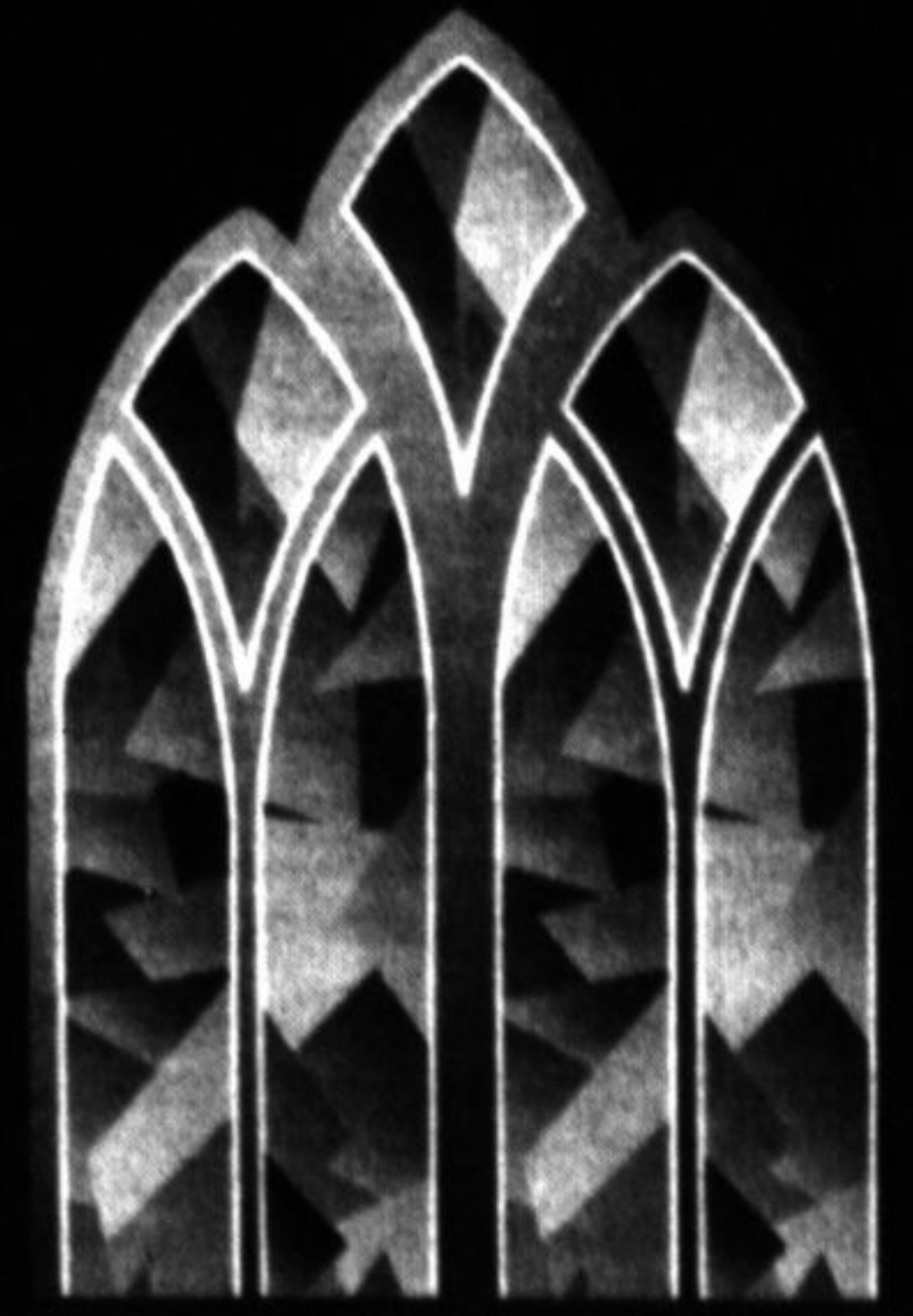
