

CONVICTED KILLER SPEAKS OUT

Kenyon wants Marion Deacon's family to know he's innocent

"I take full responsibility for Marion's death," convicted killer Paul Kenyon told The Sun-Tribune in an exclusive jailhouse interview.

"If Marion had never met Paul Kenyon, she would be alive today," he said through a glass partition over a phone. "Because of my actions, life and company I kept, Marion was murdered from that."

He thinks about her every day, he said.

Kenyon, who was convicted of second-degree murder of his girlfriend Marion Deacon, stuck to his story that one of his drug dealers killed her, not him.

Kenyon said it was not the dealer's intention to kill her. He just wanted the money Kenyon owed him for a recent purchase, but things got out of hand.

He is appealing the conviction.

Kenyon claimed Deacon, 46, was alive March 7, 2010 because they "made love a couple of times in the morning."
