Dancers head to fairs thanks to Trillium grant

Stouffville's Motus O dance theatre will be taking its act to regional fairs and people with autism, brain injury and aphasia, thanks to new funding from the provincial government.

The popular dance troupe will receive \$189,400 over three years to develop Moving Stories, a mix of new dance works and movement workshops, according to the Ontario Trillium Foundation.

Motus O will work with the Markham Fair to create and perform five shows with agricultural themes, and with Autism Ontario and the Stouffville-based York-Durham Aphasia and Acquired Brain Injury Centre on movement workshops and the formation of a dance troupe of clients and caregivers.

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"(This will allow us) to create and perform annual shows relating to agricultural fairs as part of the Markham Fair, eventually bringing our circle tent to other regional fairs as well," said Jack Langenhuizen, coartistic director/general manager of Motus O.

Workshops with Autism Ontario and York-Durham Aphasia and Acquired Brain Injury Centre will culminate into a full-length show that will be launched at the Lebovic Centre for Arts and Entertainment - Nineteen on the Park in Stouffville.

Motus O is an international touring company that creates works of pathos and comedy, fusing dance, theatre, film and music. Since its inception in 1990, it has been delighting audiences across Canada, the USA and overseas. Motus O is one of the leading dance companies in Canada performing for 25,000 people every year.
