

Main St. church 'blessed' with visit by Coptic Pope

Stouffville received a papal visit yesterday.
Pope Tawadros II, the 118th leader of the Coptic Orthodox Church, was at St. Bishoy church on Main Street.

Pope Tawadros II arrived in Toronto eight days ago for a month-long Canadian visit.

His first trip to the country is to include the consecration of the first Coptic cathedral in North America, Markham's St. Mark's Coptic Orthodox Church, visits to other parishes across Canada, meetings with religious leaders and the delivery of a lecture at Queen's University in Kingston.

Civic leaders, including Mayor Wayne Emmerson, and ministers from other churches in the community attended service at St. Bishoy yesterday.

Pope Tawadros II was so impressed with a song written for him and performed by the St. Bishoy choir, he asked for an encore. After

receiving it, during a luncheon in the church hall, he posed for photographs with the singers.

Security was tight. Several York Regional Police officers were on duty. Only invited guests were allowed on the grounds.

Preparations, including the repaving of the parking lot, were underway for weeks at St. Bishoy, across Main from Summitview Public School.

"It's such a great blessing," said Father Jacob Nadian, priest at the Stouffville church. "We are a smaller church and we weren't expecting this."

St. Bishoy opened in 2003 in the former home of Stouffville Missionary Church after it moved to a new building on Tenth Line and changed its name to EastRidge Evangelical Missionary Church.
