He started delivering milk and groceries in Toronto and then he purchased a mobile feed mixer and built the business to five grinders. He then brought the feed mill in Newmarket and Stroud to formulate feed for animals. This is where his talents grew. Without any formal training, Gordon began custom formulation of feeds, based on the unique needs of the farm and herd. His knowledge has grown into a legacy of feed formulation that is on the edge of new approaches to animal health. Upon his retirement Gordon put his knowledge of health into counseling people in the use of vitamin and mineral supplements for health challenges and terminal illness. It was one of his last tasks to create a handout on "Your Health is in your Hands". Gordon will be missed by his family and friends as well as many others for his independence of thought and life and his willingness to help nature and people wherever he could.

Passed away peacefully, after a brief illness at Markham Stouffville Hospital, on Saturday, September 20, 2014 with her family by her side at the age of 67.






