

Oakville woman killed on 404

Oakville resident Sarika Handa, 41, died Sunday morning after her vehicle collided with another car on Hwy. 404 near the Whitchurch-Stouffville/Markham border.

At about 9:30 a.m., Handa's white Honda CRV was travelling north on Hwy. 404 when it struck a Suzuki sedan near 19th Avenue.

The Honda lost control, entered the centre ditch and rolled over before coming to rest in the southbound lanes.

Handa, the lone occupant of the CRV, was ejected from the vehicle and pronounced

dead at the scene.

The Suzuki also entered the ditch, but no one was injured, police said.

Witnesses reported the Honda travelling erratically prior to the collision.

The collision is being investigated by the Ontario Provincial Police Highway Safety Division, Aurora Detachment.


