### VOTER IDENTIFICATION

When you arrive at the voting place, you must show identification to prove that you are the person whose name appears on the voters' list. The identification must show your name and qualifying address in Whitchurch-Stouffville. Photo identification is not required.

There are many documents that can be used to show your name and address, including:

- an Ontario driver's licence
- an Ontario health card (if your name and address are printed on the card)
- a mortgage, lease or rental agreement
- an insurance policy
- a credit card statement
- a bill for hydro, water, gas, telephone, cable TV

For a full list of acceptable documents: [www.townofws.ca/elections](http://www.townofws.ca/elections). For municipal election purposes, a Canadian passport is not an acceptable document, because you write your address inside your passport yourself.

**10 A.M. to 8 P.M.**

Monday, October 27, 2014 is voting day and voting places will be open from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

To avoid line-ups, the busiest times to vote are typically:

- First thing in the morning between 10 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. when the polls first open
- Following the work day between 5 p.m. to closing at 8 p.m.

The polls will close promptly at 8 p.m. If you are inside the poll or in line to vote prior to 8 p.m., you will be allowed to vote. No one else will be allowed inside the poll once the doors close at 8 p.m.

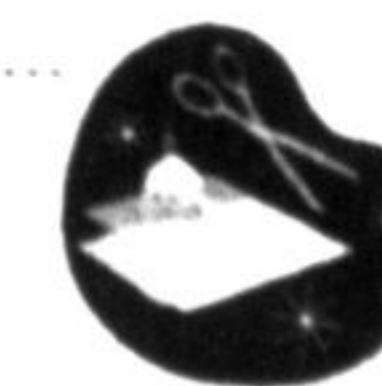
