# Pizzeria fire 'suspicious,' police say

A weekend fire at a downtown Stouffville pizza parlour is being called "suspicious" by York Regional Police. Investigators "located suspicious items both inside

and outside" of Nancy's Pizza at 6400 Main St., said police spokesperson Andy Pattenden.

The fire was called in shortly after midnight Sunday. There was thick, black smoke coming from the building, when police arrived.

Firefighters from Whitchurch-Stouffville Fire and Emergency Services were able to extinguish the blaze.

There was no one inside of the building during the fire and there were no injuries. Damage to the building was significant.

The scene was being held by police and investigators from the Office of the Fire Marshal and Emergency Management Monday.

Workers were boarding up windows Tuesday.

The restaurant, a former donut shop located next to Card's Appliances and Televisions, is popular during patio season.

As promised, we will be making Kale Soup! What we use is fresh kale of course, but also chicken, sweet onions, orzo, lemon, and herbs. It will be sold in the fresh counter; feature price will be \$5.95/900ml.

.....next, we'll be making a Tri-Colour Quinoa Salad, with the fabled kale, diced sweet peppers, sweet onions, tomatoes and black beans in a cider vinaigrette; featured at \$1.99/100g

.....and next, Blackened Salmon! This is a spicy crusted Atlantic salmon with a chive crème fraiche sauce; featured at \$3.79/100g

And lastly, we will be making Risotto Nero. Those of us who are old enough to remember Malka and Joso after Hockey Night in Canada might remember that Joso went on to open a great Dalmatian seafood restaurant on Davenport. This was, and I think it still is, one of their signature dishes. We use arborio rice, sweet onions, squid ink, white wine, butter, lemon and parmesan. It's quite a dish, and it will be featured at \$7.99 per 4" x 5" foil.
