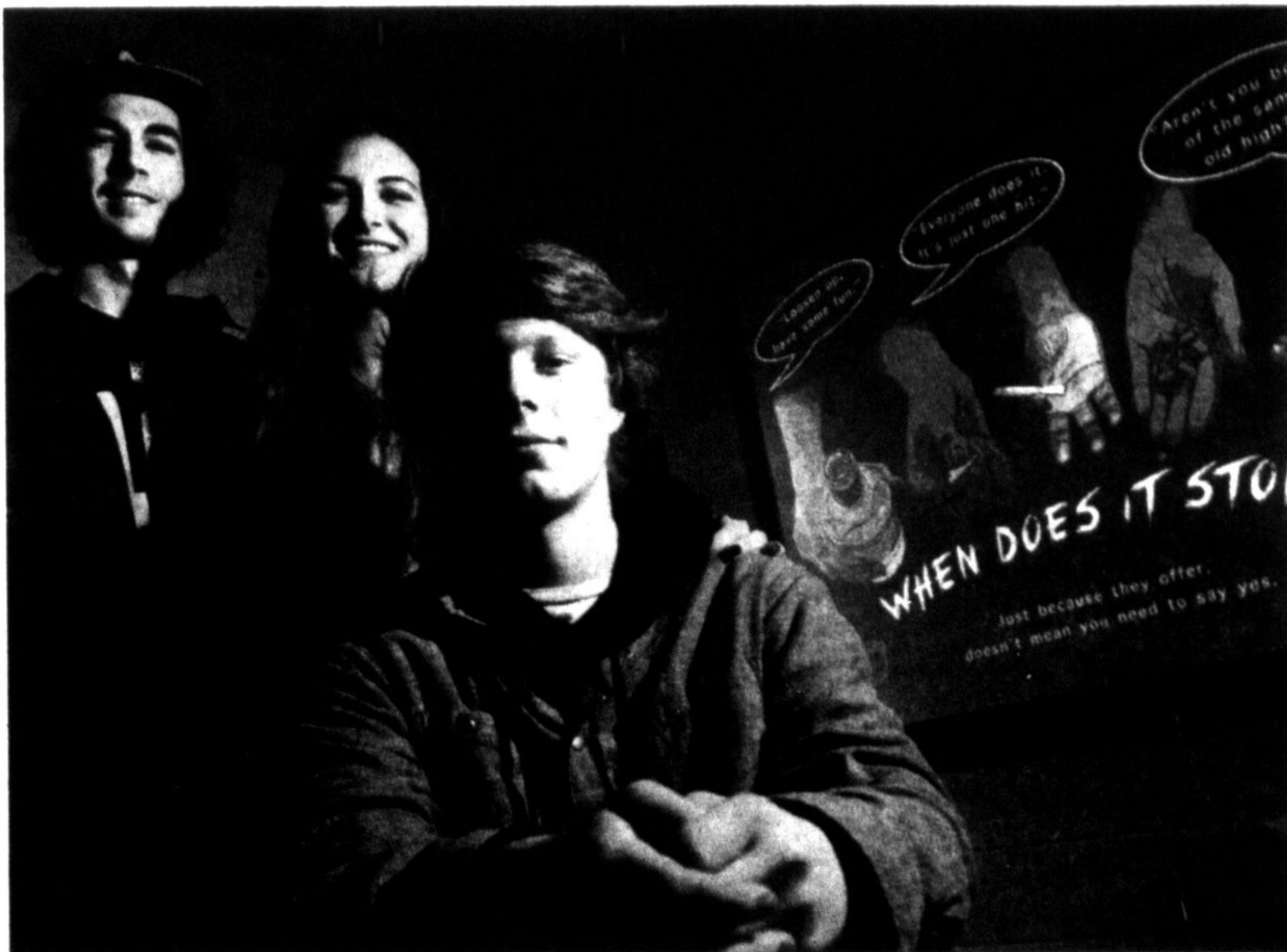


POSTER BOYS, GIRL

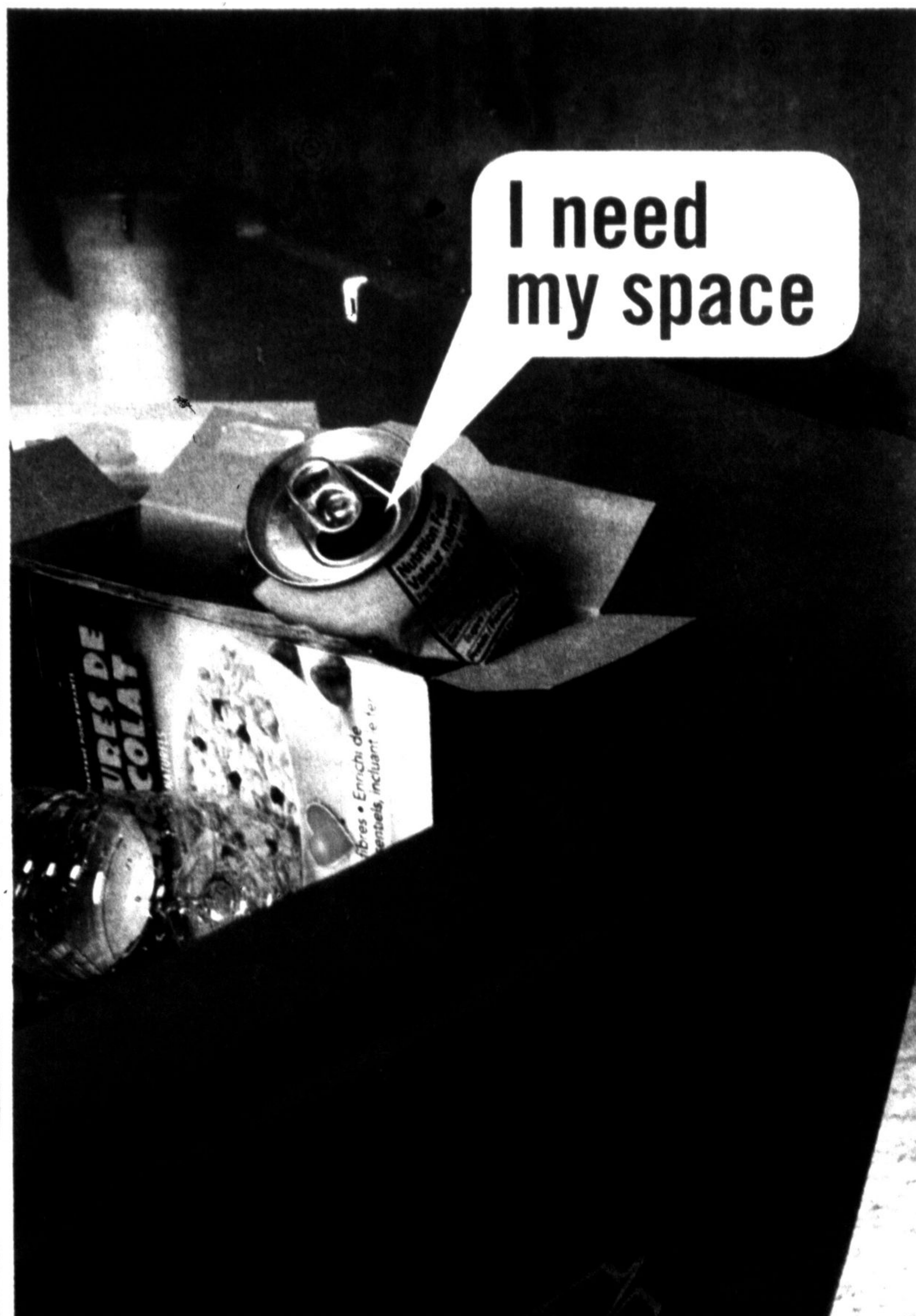
