

Council Approves 2012 Operating and Capital Budgets

Council approved the 2012 Operating and Capital budgets for the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville at its January 24 Budget & Audit Committee meeting.

Highlights from the Budget include:

- A 2.9% property tax increase (net) for the fiscal year of 2012 (this percentage includes a contribution to the capital fund as previously recommended by Council to improve capital funding and reduce future tax pressure).
- A home assessed at \$360,000 would pay an additional \$29.00 per year (Town portion only) in property taxes.
- Out of every \$1 of property taxes collected, about \$0.27 stays with the Town, while the balance pays for Regional and Education services.
- The Town's approved 2012 Operating Budget is \$50.1 million.
- The Town's approved 2012 Capital Budget is \$ 15.5 million (\$9.6M growth and \$5.9M non growth related projects).
- Council also directed staff to complete an update to the 2009 Space Requirements Study for the Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library, in order to prepare for the expansion project in the next few years.

Council Remuneration

At the January 24 meeting, Budget and Audit Committee deliberated a proposed increase for Council remuneration. Comparative data from other municipalities was considered as part of this proposal showing that the average Mayor's salary is \$64,194/year and the average Councillor salary is \$33,828/year. The changes adopted at the meeting resulted in an increase for Council remuneration which remain below the average comparator salaries (refer to table on right).

For 2014, the Mayor's and Councillors' salaries will increase based on the Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA), while the car allowance will remain at the 2013 level
