Cybersafety Series

The Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library is hosting a seminar for parents, kids and seniors, to provide awareness on internet safety and privacy.

Invest an Hour and Hack-Proof your Family takes place Jan. 31 at 7 p.m. Series facilitator Claudiu Popa will talk about the dangers of smartphones, social sites and risky online behaviour. Mr. Popa is a security and privacy risk advisor and the co-author of two books on privacy and data security.

The seminar is supported by the library and the Whitchurch-Stouffville Chamber of Commerce and offers important tips on avoiding online predators. It also addresses cyber fraud, online malware and privacy breaches.

"We will present the latest information and answer as many audience questions as we can. It will be up to the parents to make decisions regarding their children's level of access," said Mr. Poppa.
