Council Highlights by Karen Ewart

Council Highlights provide a brief summary of pertinent decisions made at a Council meeting. More information on these stones and other Council activities can be obtained from the Town's website.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM ANNUAL REVIEW

Whitchurch-Stouffville has a responsibility under the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act to review its Community Emergency Response Plan on an annual basis and as appropriate update the plan. The plan outlines how the municipality is prepared for and responds to emergency situations occurring within its jurisdictions. The areas of review includes: Critical Infrastructure and Community Risk Profile; Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (HIRA); Emergency Response Plan; Annual Exercise and Training; and Public Education on Emergency Preparedness: Whitchurch-Stouffville has met the annual regulatory compliance for an Essential Level Emergency Management program for 2012. 2012 DRINKING WATER ANNUAL REPORT

Council received the 2012 Drinking Water Annual Report for the Stouffville and the Ballantrae/Musselman's Lake Water Distribution Systems in accordance with the Safe Drinking Water Act for the period January 1st to December 31st, 2012. The report provides a general description and a review of the operation of the systems and the quality of water. GROWTH MANAGEMENT STATUS - COMMUNITY OF STOUFFVILLE: 2012 YEAR END ASSESSMENT

Another report Council received was the year end Growth Management Status Report. The report confirmed that in 2012 582 permits were issued for new residential dwelling units, which were

previously estimated as 470 new residential starts. The forecast for 2013 is approximately 350 new residential starts. Furthermore, Staff has forecast the population of the municipality will increase 5% to 43,300 people by June 2013. See Report #6 for more information.





RENOVATIONS AT LATCHAM COMPLETED

The doors to Latcham Hall have reopened for community use. In July 17, 2012, Council authorized staff to update the facility. Renovations included additional activity space; removal of the stage, levelling and replacement of the main hall floor, upgrades and replacement to the kitchen cupboards and appliances; renovations and expansion to the existing men's and ladies washrooms to meet accessibility requirements and new flooring in the main hall. Latham Hall is the interim location of the Silver Jubilee Club and will continue to accommodate other community users such as the Brownies and the Stouffville Lions during the week and leisure services programs on weekends.

The Hall was original constructed in 1970 by the Stouffville Lions Club with the financial support of Arthur Latcham, an honourary member of the Club. On February 16, 2013 the Stouffville Lions Club celebrated 75 years of serving the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville.
