Skating Club to Perform 45th Ice Revue

The 2010 Ice Revue, which takes place May 7 and 8 at Stouffville Arena, promises to appeal to skating and music fans of all ages. The revue is entitled *What's On Your iPod?* with a soundtrack that incorporates everything from techno to *The Sound of Music*.

Club seniors Taylor MacPherson and Jenna Monk, who share a passion for skating and performing, are excited about the upcoming show. "When I was really young I saw Elvis Stouko doing a huge quadruple jump on TV and that's what made me want to skate, but I didn't start until I was nine," said Taylor, who attends Brother Andre Catholic High School in Markham.

"My parents put me in skating when I was two and a half," said Jenna, who was involved in competitive synchronized skating for five or six years, but who no longer skates competitively. "During the Olympics I really loved watching Tessa (Virtue) and Scott (Moir)." The Stouffville District Secondary School

student is an avid athlete, participating in cross country, field hockey, volleyball, ice hockey and rugby.

"I think this will be my last show, because next year I'm in grade 12 and I'll be really busy," said Jenna. Taylor is also giving up skating to concentrate on getting her coaching certification. Both say they will miss the joy of performing and the camaraderie of the club.

Jenna noted that participating in a show, as opposed to skating competitively, involves less pressure. "One of the great things about performance is it doesn't hold you back," said Taylor. "You can do the same jump five times and the audience thinks it's great."

"There are so many pictures and memories," added Jenna. "You always remember the shows and you get to perform for your family and friends."

Stouffville Skating Club will perform *What's On Your iPod?* at the arena May 7 at 7 p.m. and May 8 at 2 p.m. and 7 p.m. Tickets are \$10 for adults and \$5 for seniors and children 12 and under. They can be purchased at the door.
