

EVENT HISTORY

- RELAY FOR LIFE originated in the US in 1985 and since then has grown to raise \$302.56 million through 4,200 events in 2004.
- In 1992, the British Columbia & Yukon Division held the first RELAY FOR A FRIEND in Coquitlam, based on the American Cancer Society's RELAY FOR LIFE.
- In 1998, the American Cancer Society RELAY FOR
 LIFE became the single largest fundraiser in America.
- The Canadian Cancer Society RELAY FOR LIFE launched as a pilot project in Ottawa in 1999 and raised \$85,000.
- In 2003, 10 provinces held 157 RELAY FOR LIFE events, and raised more than 16 million.
- Today, RELAY FOR LIFE has grown to become the Canadian Cancer Society's national signature event, with 214 community and youth events across Canada, raising more than \$22 million.
- This year, we anticipate growth to over 298 events, with a goal of over \$28.4 million.
- Internationally, RELAY FOR LIFE events take place in 8 countries.
