My Week with Marilyn will be screened at Nineteen on the Park on May 9 at 7 p.m. The film provides a fascinating dramatized glimpse of Marilyn Monroe during the shooting of *The Prince and The Showgirl*.

When Sir Laurence Olivier is making the movie in London, an eager young film student, Colin Clark, negotiates a job on the set. When Monroe arrives, Olivier struggles to cope with her demands and lack of confidence, while Clark develops a rapport with the actress which helps her to overcome her fears and deliver an electrifying performance. The film is based on Clark's memoir, *The Prince, The Showgirl and Me*.

In his review of the film, Rolling Stone critic Peter Travers wrote, "It took a toll on Marilyn Monroe to look effortlessly buoyant on camera. Michelle Williams lets us see why. It's a great, soulful performance. Sit back and behold."

On May 23 at 7 p.m., Starlight Cinema presents *Café de Flore*, directed by Jean-Marc Vallée (C.R.A.Z.Y.), one of Canada's most compelling filmmakers. "Café de Flore is a deeply emotional love story between two families, gently interweaving the past with the present like two films," noted Brenda Lieberman, lead programmer for the Calgary International Film Festival.

"The audience is left endlessly curious as to the relationship between both worlds. Jean-Marc Vallée has skillfully crafted a very subtle, yet extremely detailed film, beautifully shot from beginning to end. His unique story structure blurs the line between love and sadness, the challenges of accepting reality and the ability to let go."

In her review of the movie, Time critic Mary Corless wrote, "The film is generous to all its besotted creatures, and to the audience as well. Viewers who fall in love with *Café de Flore* will find that it loves them back."

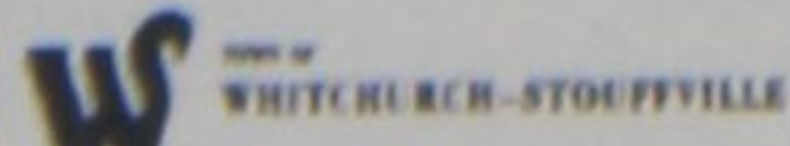
